On October 30, 2011 at 20:42 hours, the Springfield Twp. Police were detailed to 1800 Jacksonville-Jobstown Road for the report of smoke coming from the area of the Animal Kingdom. Ptl. Angela Sklodowski, Ptl. Kevin O'Malley and I were on a domestic dispute call approximately a mile from the location. Ptl. O'Malley departed our current location to respond to the area the smoke was observed. A brief period had passed when Ptl. O'Malley came across the radio reporting a large column of smoke coming from the area of 1800 Jacksonville-Jobstown Road - The Animal Kingdom. Ptl. Sklodowski and I cleared our location and responded to 1800 Jacksonville-Jobstown Road. Upon our arrival, I observed smoke and flames coming from the rear of the main building. Ptl. O'Malley was already at the rear of the business with Jose Ortiz, a caretaker, trying to remove giraffes from their pens. The pens for the giraffes are located inside the main building on the east, rear side.

I was able to gain access to the business by breaking open the doors to the main customer entrance. Both Ptl. Sklodowski and I attempted to enter the building before being forced out by the heavy smoke condition inside. Shortly after, a tanker truck from the Jacksonville Fire Department arrived on location. Upon the arrival of additional fire personnel, several fire fighters, including Anthony Knighten, Mathew Reevy and David Raymond entered the structure and started removing animals.

I contacted Central Communications (P4) and requested that the Burlington County Fire Marshal, the New Jersey State Police Arson-Bomb Unit and the NJSPCA respond to the location.

With the assistance of Springfield Twp. EMS, Ptl. Sklodowski and I performed first aid on several animals suffering from the effects of the fire. Ptl. O'Malley came from the back of the building to where Ptl. Sklodowski and I were located. Ptl. O'Malley advised me that he and Jose Ortiz were able to remove several giraffes from the building, including a severely burned young giraffe. However, they were unable to rescue the young giraffe's mother who was located deeper inside the building, which was being consumed by the fire.

Upon the arrival of the NJSP Arson-Bomb Unit and the Burlington County Fire Marshal, the scene was turned over.

Ptl. O'Malley, Ptl. Sklodowski, Ptl. Czepiel of Florence Twp. Police Department and I assisted a veterinarian in placing the severely burned giraffe on a back board and transporting it to the front of the business to provide further medical treatment.

Springfield Twp. Police Chief Eric Trout was briefed on the incident upon his arrival followed by Springfield Twp. Mayor Dennis McDaniel a short time later.

During the course of the fire, Ptl. O'Malley suffered an injury to his ankle, while Ptl. Sklodowski suffered an injury to her right wrist. Both officers were advised by Sgt. Antonucci to respond to the hospital to be evaluated. Westampton Twp. EMS transported both Ptl. O'Malley and Ptl. Sklodowski to Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly, NJ.

Police Chief Eric Trout and I cleared the location at 05:50 hours.
