Origin/Details: On this date this writer was assigned to uniform patrol of th day shift (0800-1600) and was issued marked patrol vehicle A-9. The rear compartment of the vehcile was checked prior to entering service and was found to be clear. At approximatley 0925 hours I was flagged down at Brighton and Atlantic Avenues by the above named victim. I notified police dispatch of my status and location. As I pulled to the curb and the female approached my vheicle, her face was red, and she was bleeding from her nose/upper lip area, her face also showed several scratch marks. The victim told me that she had been assaulted and that she had called 911 prior to flagging me down.

Interview: The victim, [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] was interviewed at Brighton and Atlantic Avenues and stated the following: [REDACTED] stated that she lives [REDACTED] and is employed [REDACTED]

On this date while checking 9 North Stenton Place, found a white female, long dark hair wearing a black dress asleep under the steps. [REDACTED] stated that she woke the female and told her that she was not permitted to sleep there. [REDACTED] said that the female got up and then tried to enter the front door of 2809 Brighton Avenue, (another property she manages) and again told the female that she does not live there and to leave. [REDACTED] said that the female became violent, knocking her to the ground by pulling her hair. [REDACTED] said that the girl then sat on top of her, puching her in her face and scratching at her eyes and face. [REDACTED] stated that she was screaming for help and an unidentified male passerby pulled the female off her. The female went west on Atlantic Avenue and got onto New Jersey Transit Bus 509. Sharp stated that she then called 911 on her cell phone. [REDACTED] described the



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female as being white, 5'4" to 5'5", medium build, between 20-25 years of age. She said the female was wearing a black dress and was carrying high heels. [REDACTED] stated that she wanted to sign a criminal complaint for assault if the female was located.

Action Taken: I contacted dispatch via radio and provided a detailed description of the suspect as provided by the victim. I requested that New Jersey Transit be notified regarding bus 509. I asked that female if she needed medical attention for her wounds and she declined at this time. I then transported [REDACTED] to the Public Safety Building to the General Investigations Section to sign a complaint (dispatch notified and mileage given), upon arriving the rear compartment of the vehicle was checked and found to be clear. [REDACTED] was escorted to GIS and met with Det. S. Friel. While in GIS I was contacted by dispatch and was told that Northfield Police had stopped the bus and located a female matching the description. Northfield also advised that the female had outstanding warrants for her arrest. I was then told that Northfield Police would transport the female to the city limits and turn the female over to us. I was dispatched to the city line on US Route 40 and awaited Northfield PD. I was again contacted by Northfield PD and told that the female also had illegal Controlled Dangerous Substance and that she was being processed for the cds and the warrant. Northfield asked if I could respond to their department to take possession of the female. I responded to Northfield Police Department and took the female into custody for the assault. The female was identified as follows:

Female was placed into handcuffs, (adjusted to fit and double locks applied) and placed in the rear compartment of the patrol vehicle. I notified dispatch of my transport from Northfield PD to the Public Safety Building, starting and ending mileage provided. Once in the rear parking lot of the PSB I was met by Detective C. Argus. The female was removed from the vehicle and positive identification was made by Sharp. The female was then taken to Booking and Detention for processing. I then returned to the detective bureau to complete reports. Female was charged with simple assault by [REDACTED] charges placed on summons. No further action taken.

On the above noted date and time this report writer was requested to conduct an in person show up by Det Friel. The victim in this case is a [REDACTED]. The accused in this case was brought to the rear of the public Safety building by Ofc. Clint Seltzer, she was standing in the rear parking lot. Through the inner rear door windows [REDACTED] was able to clearly see the accused and positively identified her as being her assailant in this case.

I, Det. S. Walsh-Friel, interviewed the above victim in reference to an assault. [REDACTED] face was visibly bloody, red, and brush burned. [REDACTED] also had a small cut on her left hand. A taped interview was conducted because she lost her glasses during the assault and could not see to write a statement.

I interviewed [REDACTED] in the Detective Bureau of the ACPD.

Below is a synopsis of the interview with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] manages a few building in the Unit North Block of Stenton Place.

-While checking on one of the buildings [REDACTED] observed a white female sleeping under a set of steps.

[REDACTED] told the female to leave the property

-The female then began trying the doors to the property

[REDACTED] again told the female to leave the property

-The female then walked around the block and returned to 9 N. Stenton Ave.

-The female then began pulling [REDACTED] hair, along with throwing her to the ground and punching her in the face.

-The female also was scratching and grabbing [REDACTED] face

-An unknown male had to pull the female off of [REDACTED]

-The female then got on a NJ Transit bus number 509

[REDACTED] then flagged down Ofc. Seltzer

[REDACTED] describes the female as a white female, approx. 5'09, 130 lbs, 25 yrs. old, long black stragly hair, wearing a black dress with ruffles, and holding black high heels.

See Seltzer's report for further details of the case.

While [REDACTED] was still in the Detective Bureau, Ofc. Seltzer, advised me Northfield had the female in custody. Northfield found outstanding warrants on the female along with charging her with Possession of CDS. Ofc. Seltzer then went to Northfield to get the female for identification for the assault against [REDACTED]

See Det. Jasiecki's report for the positive identification of Licpe by Sharp.

Licpe was placed on a summons for simple assault (S2011-005923).

Two photographs along with the CD interview of [REDACTED] were placed in ACPD Property room as evidence.

Devon Licpe states she was assaulted by a Susan Sharp. LIEPE states the suspect SHARP grabbed her arm throwing her to the ground causing bruises and scratches to her arms, legs, knees, feet and body.

The victim states she will produce pictures.

Summons issued for assault S-2012-004093
