This Officer along Officer S. Swieringa were dispatched to 5 Burns Lane West on a report of a domestic dispute in progress. Upon arriving we were met outside the residence by the Victim, Susan Friedman and her son David. Ms. Friedman reported that she had been assaulted by her Son-in-law Christopher Callahan. The victim explained that she had come to see her daughter Loire on her birthday and that while there her son-in-law Chris (Loire's husband) came home from work. There has been bad blood between the two for a long time and today the issues came to blows. According to both Mr. Callahan and Ms. Friedman they exchanged words

which lead to heated words. The confrontation got out of hand when Mr. Callahan spit in his mother in-law's face. She then slapped him in the face with such force it left a red mark on his face and caused him severe pain. Although there have been numerous incidents between the two in the past they have never gotten physical before. This time however when Ms. Friedman struck Christopher in the face with the force she did he just reacted and defended himself. He struck Ms. Friedman on the left side of the face breaking her glasses and cutting her eye. The Sayreville First Aid Squad responded and treated the victims injuries which included a

~~_____~~ . She was transported her to Old Bridge Hospital. Mr. Callahan was arrested and taken to Headquarters where he was processed and released after posting bail which was set at \$10,000 NO 10% by Judge Weber.

On October 12, 2013, at approximately 23:43 hours, Ptl. Soto, Ptl. Lugo, and I (Ptl. Maslowski) responded to 5 Byrnes Ln. W. for the report of a welfare check. Ptl. Lestuck was speaking with the reporting person at HQ who advised they heard arguing at that residence. Upon arrival, I spoke with Mr. Christopher Callahan and Mrs. Lori Callahan who were both surprised by

my arrival. I then spoke with Lori outside who stated she just came home from being out with her parents and she and Chris were talking loudly when her mother called her on the phone. Lori confirmed the account of the previous incident that her parents advised Ptl. Lestuck. I then spoke with Chris who stated that he was angry that his wife was late and after she arrived home and argument ensued with him and Mr. Richard Friedman. Chris and Lori both confirmed that they in fact were having a verbal argument which was now over. Both parties advised that the argument never became physical and I did not observe any signs of injuries. Lori stated she would be sleeping on the couch today to allow the situation to calm down. No further police action at this time. See Ptl. Lestuck report for further.
