**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR
"KIDS RECREATION TRUST FUND" GRANT
FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF CLARK**

WHEREAS the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders has established the Kids Recreation Trust Fund to allocate grant funds for the creation, enhancement and/or replacement of recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS the Township of Clark desires to submit a grant application to seek funding in the amount of \$50,000.00 for improvements to Memorial Park (The Pit) including the addition of a pickle ball court and playground item(s) to be added to existing fixtures in accordance with the established guidelines of the grant, including accepting the award and executing an agreement with Union County; and

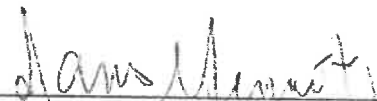

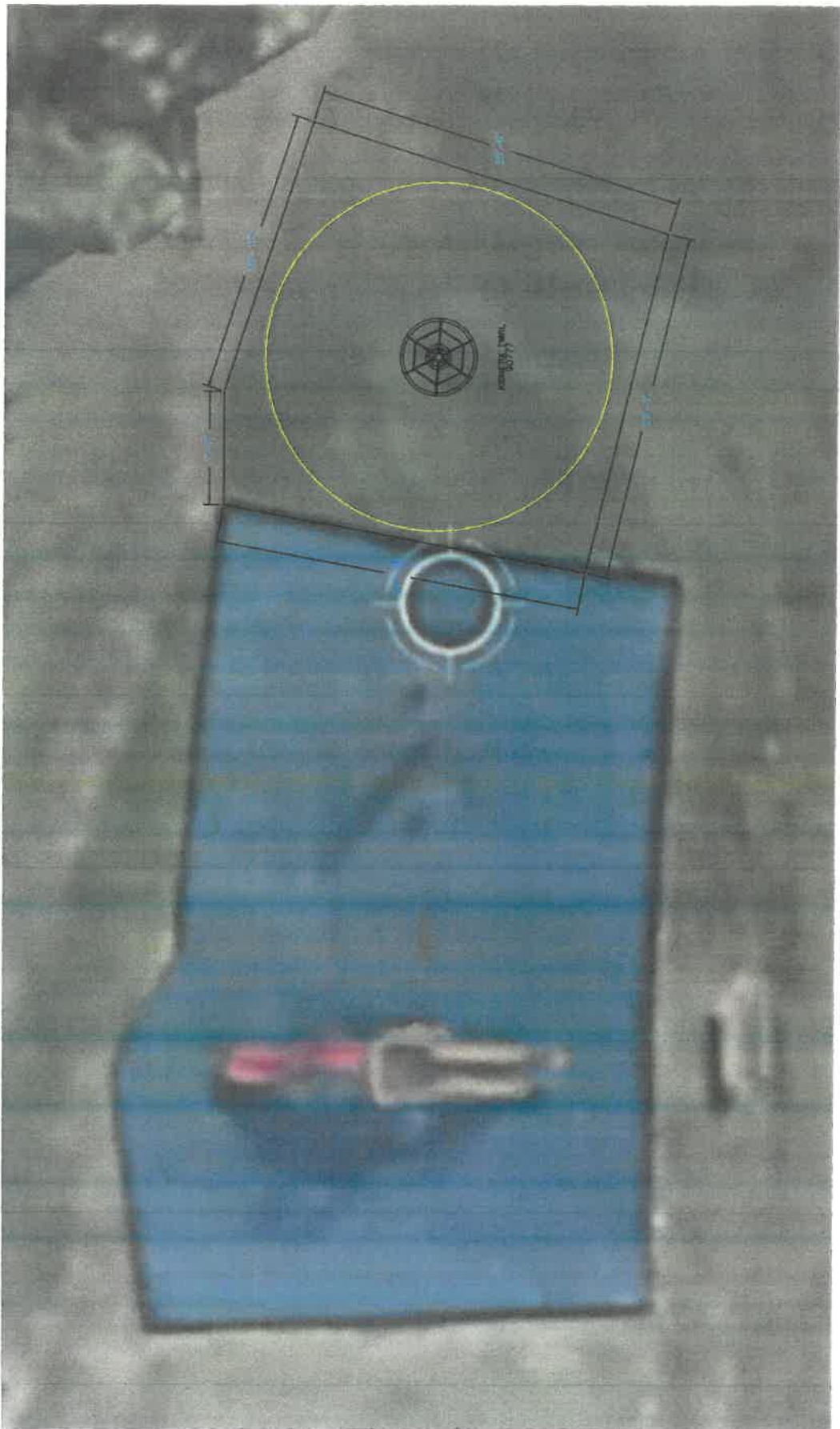

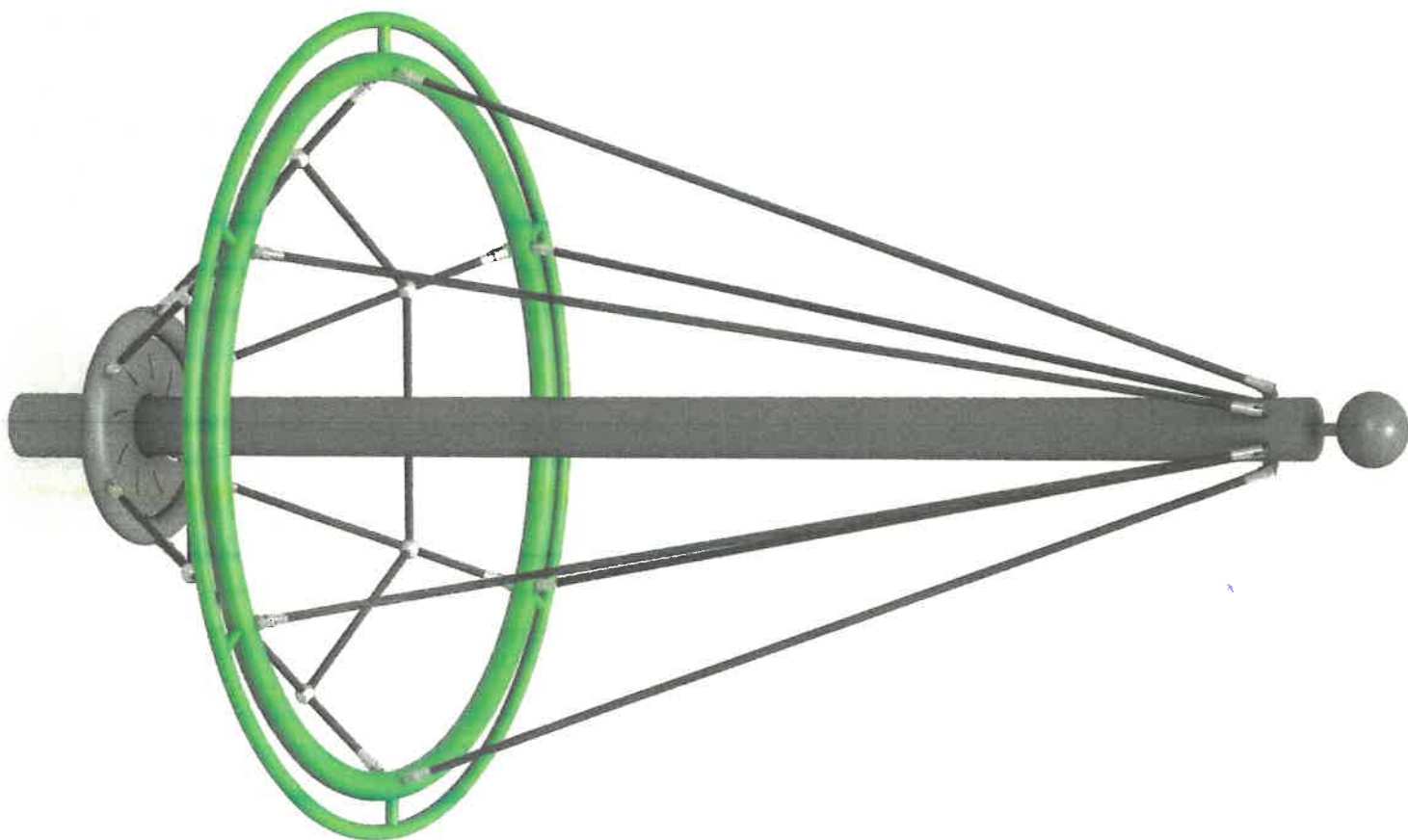

4. Install 4' high, chain link fence at edge of pavement. All fence fabric and posts to be black. There will be two (2) 4' wide openings for player access.
5. Restore access walkway and any grass areas disturbed by construction.
6. Apply temporary playing lines for Fall 2022.
7. In Spring 2023, apply acrylic resurfacer.
8. Apply NovaCombination color coating.
9. Tape and hand paint playing lines.

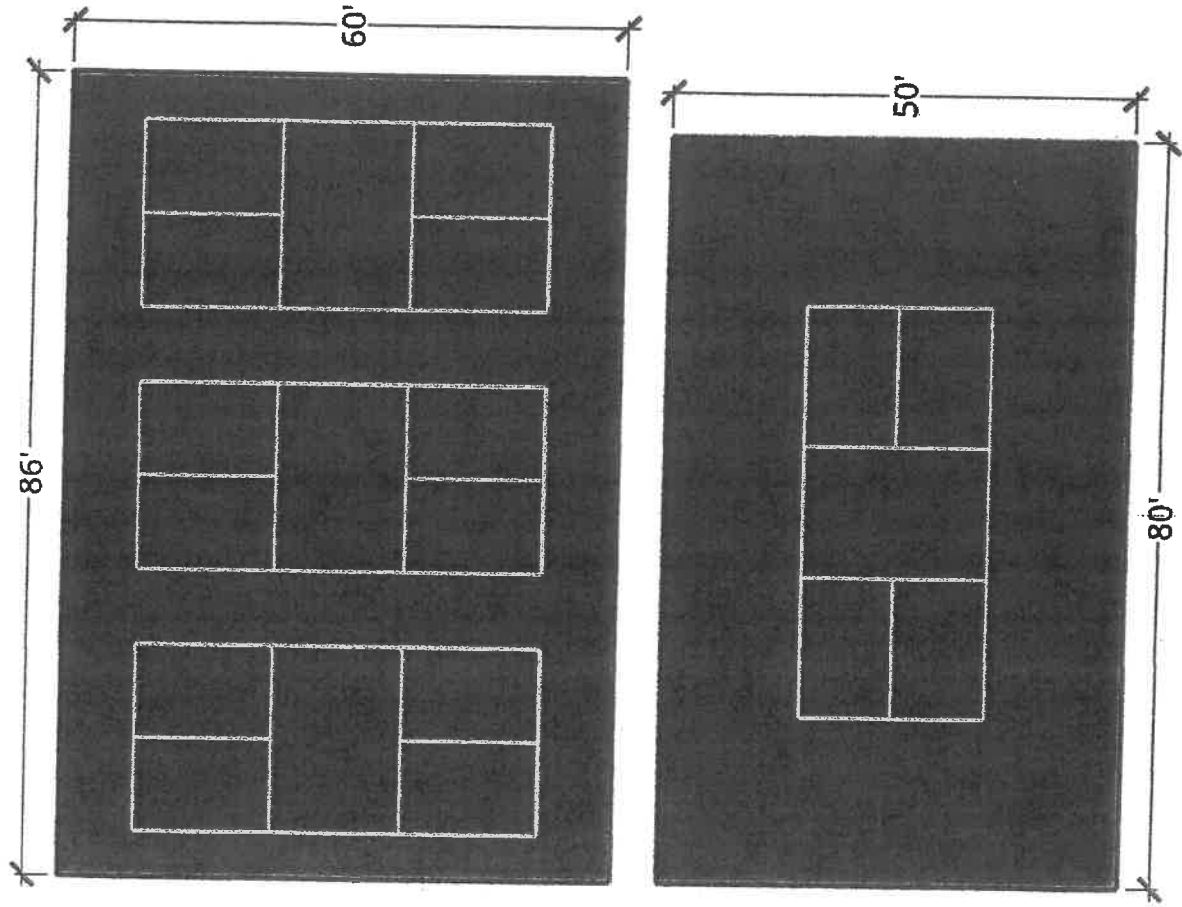

3. Install 2" thick, hot mix asphalt stabilized base course, mix 19M64 (1-2) for expanded court area.
4. Install three (3) sets of pickleball court nets in new concrete footing.
5. Sweep surface free of all loose debris and apply tack coat.
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8. Restore access walkway and any grass areas disturbed by construction.
9. Apply temporary playing lines for Fall 2022.
10. In Spring 2023, apply acrylic resurfacer.
11. Apply NovaCombination color coating.
12. Tape and hand paint playing lines.
