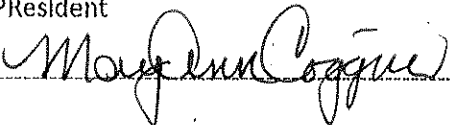

INCIDENT: Drug Overdose

LOCATION: 1636 Simpson Avenue, Ocean City, NJ 08226

REPORT:

On August 29, 2023, at approximately 1:00 PM, I responded to 1636 Simpson Avenue for the report of a drug overdose. Lt. Randles, Sgt. Gheen and Ptl. Fiorentino also responded.

Upon arrival, the front door to the residence was unlocked and partially open. I entered the property where I observed the caller, Robert Hughes, in the hallway stating that his son, [REDACTED], overdosed on what he believes is Fentanyl and was laying on the bathroom floor. I entered the bathroom and observed [REDACTED] laying on his back on the bathroom floor. [REDACTED] face was blue in color and had occasional gasps for air. [REDACTED] pupils were also pinpoint and his eyes were rolled into the back of his head. I then administered one dose of narcan into [REDACTED] nostril and began to sternum rub his chest. After approximately 2 minutes [REDACTED] condition remained the same. I then administered a second dose of narcan into [REDACTED] nostril. Approximately after 1 minute of the second dose [REDACTED] began to gasp for air more frequently and began to open his eyes. Ocean City Fire then took over and began to administer oxygen to [REDACTED]. Approximately 3-5 minutes after the first dose of narcan [REDACTED] recovered and started breathing normally. [REDACTED] then was able to sit up on his own and immediately stood up with the help of the OCFD.

[REDACTED] was then brought into the living room of the house where he was seated on a chair and evaluated by OCFD. [REDACTED] denied taking anything which would of caused him to overdose. Robert stated that OCPD was at his house on August 18th for a prior overdose incident (PD-23-37316). [REDACTED] then agreed to go to with OCFD to Shore Medical Center for further treatment and evaluation.

An ODMAP and Narcan Deployment Form were completed for this incident.

An L-3 Case has been created for this case, and email notifications have been sent to police records and IT.

Incident: Drug Overdose

Location: 1636 Simpson Avenue, Ocean City, NJ 08226

Narrative:

On Friday, August 18th, 2023, at approximately 2:58 A.M., Sgt. Clark, Ptl. Monzo, and I responded to a report of an unconscious male with C.P.R. in progress at the above listed address. Upon my arrival, I found the door to the residence locked. After knocking several times, the homeowner, Robert J. Hughes opened the door and stated his son, [REDACTED] was in the back of the residence and that, "He needs narkan."

Sgt. Clark, Ptl. Monzo, and I made our way to the back of the residence where [REDACTED] was lying unresponsive with no pulse on the back porch. Sgt. Clark immediately administered a single dose of narkan and I began C.P.R.. Moments later, the Fire Department arrived and began applying an A.E.D.. After approximately thirty (30) seconds of compressions, [REDACTED] was successfully resuscitated and began breathing. Moments later, [REDACTED] regained consciousness and was transported to Shore Memorial Medical Hospital by paramedics.

I spoke with [REDACTED] father, Robert, who stated [REDACTED] was recently arrested in Atlantic City for drug related charges and subsequently brought to Philadelphia on existing warrants. After seeing a judge in Philadelphia, [REDACTED] was released and had approximately, "Two hours to get whatever he wanted" before

Robert picked him up around 8:30 P.M. on August 17th. Robert stated he and [REDACTED] arrived at their residence in Ocean City around 12:00 A.M. on August 18th. Robert stated he last saw [REDACTED] around 12:45 A.M., and after waking up approximately two hours later to use the restroom, Robert found [REDACTED] unconscious on the back porch.

After looking around the residence for evidence related to the overdose, a syringe and rubber tie-off were located on the floor of the bathroom. Additionally, a glass pipe with residue was located on the back porch near where [REDACTED] was found. No drugs were able to be located. The syringe, rubber tie-off, and glass pipe were collected and sealed in evidence bags, logged into B.E.A.S.T. as evidence to be destroyed, and stored in the evidence locker at Police Headquarters. Capt. Schaffer was notified of the overdose. DLt. Sullivan and DSgt. Lancaster were also notified concerning this case.

An ODMAP and narcan deployment form were completed.

No further action was taken by this Officer.

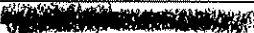

Report: On May 21, 2023, at approximately 2:58 PM, responded to the 1441 Central Avenue to check on the well-being of [REDACTED]'s friend, Thomas Fontana called the police requesting a well-being of her. It was reported that [REDACTED] was highly intoxicated and might have overdosed on medication and was possibly suicidal. Police and Fire/Rescue were dispatched to the scene and we arrived at the property at the same time.

[REDACTED] was located in the back bedroom lying in bed. She was obviously intoxicated and confused. She was rambling and making irrational statement. On the night stand next to her be was two empty 1.5 Liter bottles of yellow tail wine and a pill bottle of blood thinner medication prescribed to [REDACTED]

I spoke with Thomas Fontana on facetime for a few minutes. He was away for military training for the next few weeks. Thomas explained that [REDACTED] had been staying at his place for a week however; she left last night to come and stay in Ocean City at her parents' house. She had called him obviously under the influence of something so he called 911 for have her medically checked.

Fire/Rescue placed [REDACTED] in an awaiting ambulance and transported her to Shore Medical Center for further medical treatment.

While we were on scene a group of [REDACTED]'s friends returned to the house from the beach. (Nicholas Santana, Sarah Rothwell, Jaime Morales, Xochilt Davis-Alicea and Christopher Mook)

The group was cooperative and did not appear to be under the influence of anything. I spoke with Nicholas who explained that [REDACTED] invited him and some friends for the night and they all came to the house yesterday. Nicholas gave me [REDACTED] mother's (Paula Rios) telephone number so I could inform her of the incident.

After speaking with Paula Rios, the investigation learned that Nicholas is [REDACTED] boyfriend and they have a 5 month old child together. Paula and her husband have full custody of the baby and [REDACTED] reside with them in Ambler, PA.

Paula explained that [REDACTED] suffers from some mental health issues and is under the care of a doctor. She also has some health issues where she developed pulmonary blood clots and that is why is has blood thinner medication.

Paula stated the family has been having ongoing problems regarding Nicholas and they are trying to keep their daughter separated from him. Paula said that Nicholas is facing very serious criminal charge in Pennsylvania for breaking into a persons home and striking him with a tire iron. According to Paula, Nicholas if facing numerous criminal charges including attempted murder for severally injuring another man that [REDACTED] was staying with. Also the last time Nicholas was at their house in Ocean City, he caused a large amount of criminal mischief to the interior of the property but the family never reported it to this police agency.

Paula stated that Nicholas and his friends are not welcome at the property and she wants them out immediately. If Nicholas returns to the property she will sign criminal complaints. Nicholas and his friends were advised they are not welcomed at the property and left without incident.

On Saturday, February 25, 2023, at approximately 6:08 P.M., Matthew Roselle called 911 stating that his girlfriend was overdosing. At this time I activated my overhead lights and sirens.

Upon arriving, at the above-listed address, I grabbed my personal medical kit from the rear of my police vehicle 17-19. The main entrance at 1704 West Avenue had a see-through screen door. I was able to see a white male who was later identified as Matthew Roselle at the front door. I instructed M. Roselle to tell me where the female was overdosing. M. Roselle brought me to the rear bedroom located on the second floor.

In the rear bedroom, I saw a white female lying on her back on the floor. The white female was later identified as [REDACTED] was unconscious and in a good position, at this time [REDACTED] had a weak pulse and low shallow breathing.

At this time, it was determined that [REDACTED] was overdosing. I opened a Narcan nasal spray that contained 4mg of Naloxone. I inspected the Narcan and administered the spray into [REDACTED]'s right nostril. Shortly after administering the first Narcan, I was unsure if it had any effect. I elected to use another Narcan. I opened a Narcan nasal spray that contained 4mg of Naloxone. I inspected the Narcan and administered the spray into Randall's left nostril.

I instructed Ptl. Gallagher and Ptl. Diluzio to take M. Roselle downstairs to get information on what occurred.

At this time Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene. Sgt. Clark, Sgt. Wilson, Ptl. Diluzio and Ptl. Gallagher were also on scene.

Fire and Rescue started work on [REDACTED]. Approximately 1-3 minutes later [REDACTED] came to. [REDACTED] was in shock due to her recent overdose and there being so many people in the residence.

[REDACTED] at first was unable to make complete sentences and was in a daze. After a few minutes, [REDACTED] regained her wits and was able to make complete sentences. I explained to [REDACTED] that she had just overdosed and that the police and fire units were there because of that. I further explained to [REDACTED] that we had to use Narcan on her due to her overdosing. Ptl. Gallagher and I asked if she had ever overdosed before which she stated she had. Fire performed their initial assessments and confirmed that she was stable. [REDACTED] ultimately refused to be transported to Shore Memorial Hospital.

At this time M. Roselle's parents arrived on the scene, I spoke to Daniel Roselle and Roberta Roselle in the living room. I informed the two of the situation and suggested that they transport [REDACTED] to the hospital. Sgt. Wilson also handed Daniel Roselle and Roberta Roselle a Narcan kit. The Narcan Kit had pamphlets and an additional Narcan nasal spray.
