The South Jersey Port Corporation (“SJPC”) received your Open Public Records Act (“OPRA”) request on May 19, 2026. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 1, 2026.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request.

1. Salem County Roll-back memorandum of judgment for Block 96, Lot 5.

These record(s) are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request; and are enclosed with this response. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is **\$0.00**.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the SJPC. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Counsel (“GRC”) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by email at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Superior Court Clerk in your County.
