Public Participation at the Board Meeting

Section 7.4 of the Middlesex College Board of Trustees bylaws provides that “Any organization, group, or individual from within or without the College will be recognized to be heard on agenda items provided that requests to be heard shall have been registered with the Assistant Secretary at least twenty-four hours before the meeting.”

In order to participate during the public comment portion of the upcoming Board meeting, an individual must register with the Assistant Secretary of the Board by sending an e-mail message to boardassistantsecretary@middlesexcc.edu no later than 8:30 a.m. on the calendar day prior to the Board meeting.

- Only those individuals who register at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting with the Assistant Secretary of the Board will be called upon to address the Board.
- Please be sure your name appears on Zoom and matches the name you used to register to speak.
- A College staff member will announce the name of each individual and will call upon them to address the Board in the order in which they registered and will announce the registered
