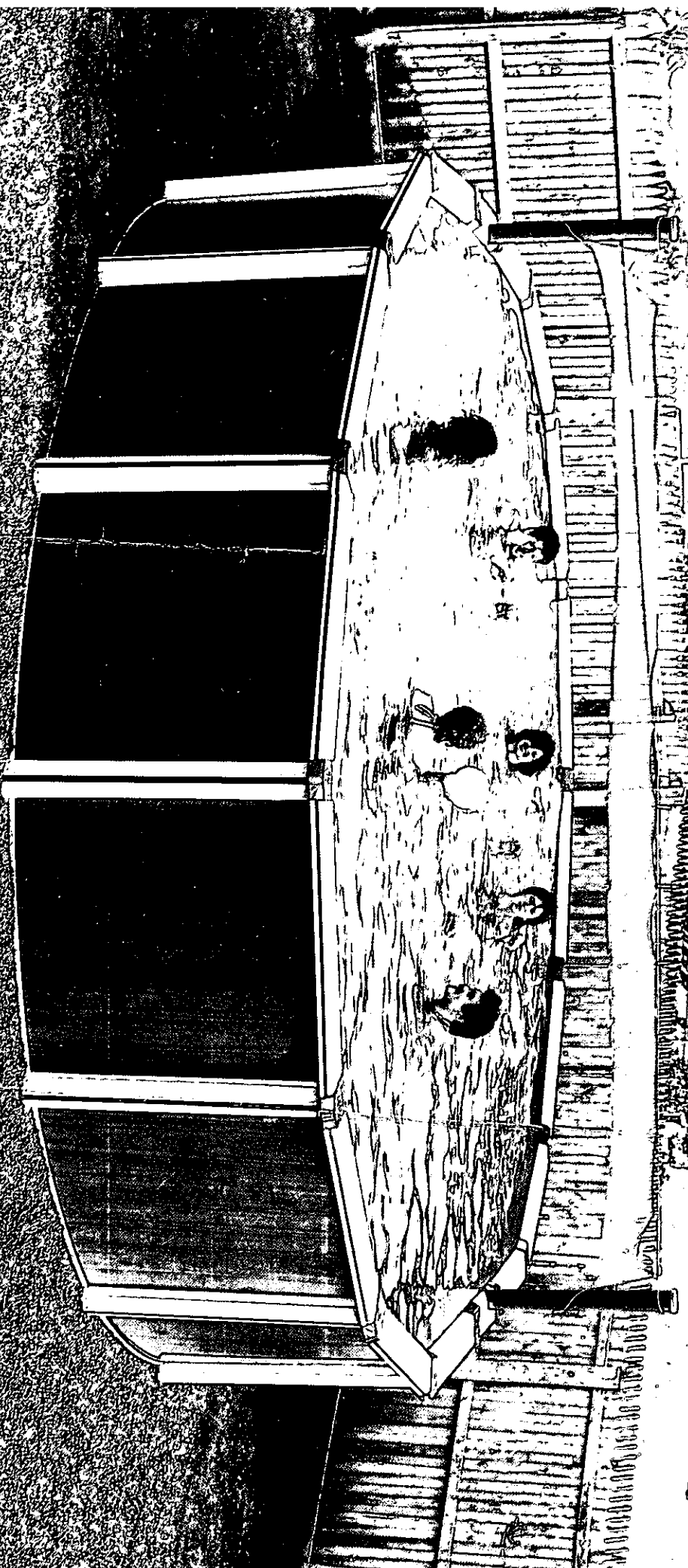

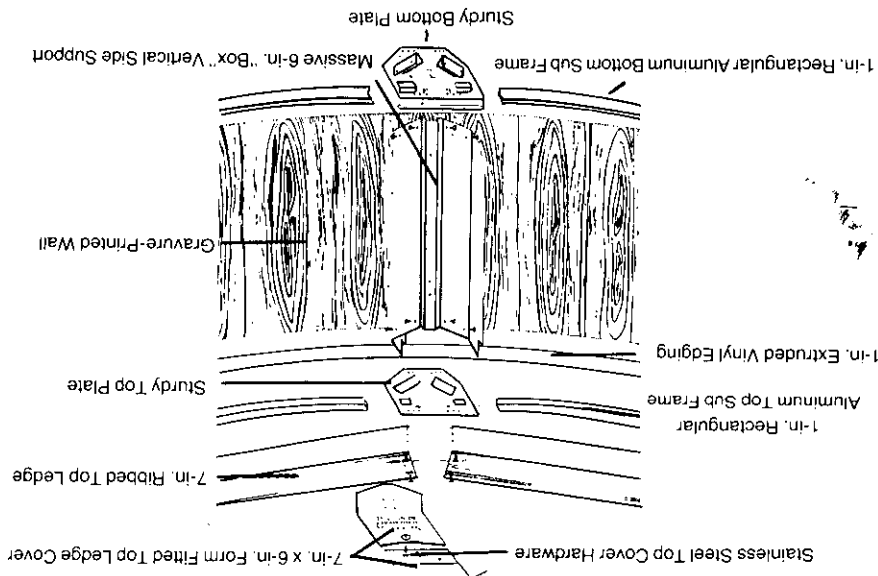

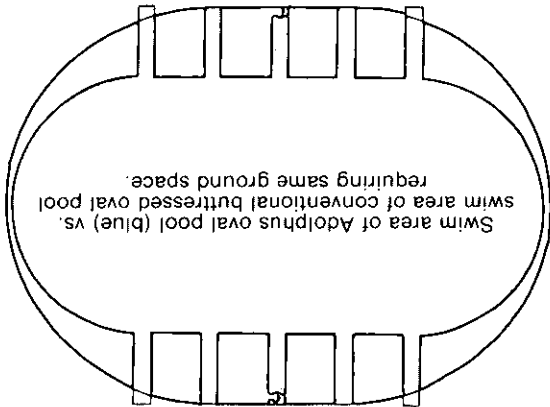

Swim area of Adolphus oval pool (blue) vs. swim area of conventional buttressed oval pool requiring same ground space.



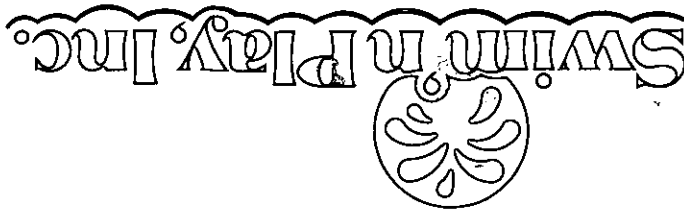
