On the above date and time, I, Ptl. Schiano, responded to 32 Blaine Avenue in reference for a fire alarm that is going off. Upon arrival, I was met my Code Enforcement Officer Kenneth Roberts.

Roberts and I found that the alarm was going off in the apartment unit in the backyard of the residence. At this time, Roberts attempted to contact the property owner multiple times via cellular phone call, but failed to come in contact.

Roberts then was able to enter the apartment unit through the open window to which he found it was just a faulty alarm sensor that was going off. Roberts then disabled the alarm for the time being and would later try to contact the property owner once again to notify them.

At this time, I informed dispatch that I would be clear and that it was just a faulty fire alarm going off which was disabled. I then left the scene without further incident.
