Upon entering the lobby I informed the male party, Mr. Victor M Queiro (who shall be further referred to as the complainant), our interaction was being video and audio recorded on my department issued body worn camera. The complainant stated his neighbor, Mr. Justin T Brown, who resides at 752 Colonial Blvd has mental health issues. Further stating he has previously signed citizen complaints for stalking against Mr. Brown and would like to report an incident which occurred on June 5, 2025. On June 5, 2025 the complainant stated upon returning to his residence, Mr. Brown was in his driveway speaking to himself about the complainant's occupation and remarks regarding his wife, specifically by mumbling under his breathe, "cop" and "cop's wife". The complainant informed me due to the nature of his occupation, North Bergen Police Officer, Mr. Brown believes he is surveilling his residence. The complainant stated he has observed a trend of Mr. Brown's behavior throughout the years and he tends to act erratic and have out bursts during the summer months. The complainant stated he does not wish to file citizen complaint or complete a written statement form rather just put the matter on record.

WHEN HE ANSWERED, THE CALLER ASKED IN A ROBOTIC VOICE "IS THIS OFFICER VICTOR AT [REDACTED]?" (IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT MR. QUEIRO IS A POLICE OFFICER). MR. QUEIRO TOLD THE CALLER IT WAS THE WRONG NUMBER AND HUNG UP. ON THE MORNING OF 05/27/2023 AT APPROXIMATELY 0315 HOURS, MR. QUEIRO WAS WOKEN UP TO THE SOUND OF A CAR HORN. HE LOOKED OUT HIS BEDROOM WINDOW AND SAW THE VEHICLE BELONGING TO HIS NEIGHBOR (BLACK CADILLAC CTS BEARING NY REGISTRATION JJN4902) FACING HIS HOUSE. HE STARTED TO GO BACK TO BED WHEN HE HEARD ANOTHER HORN, ONLY THIS TIME THE VEHICLE WAS FACING HIS NEIGHBOR AT 6 COLONIAL BLVD. HILLSDALE, NJ. MR. QUEIRO WENT BACK TO SLEEP AND IN THE MORNING SPOKE WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, JASON GARELICK FROM 6 COLONIAL BLVD. MR. GARELICK INFORMED HIM THAT IN ADDITION TO THE CAR HORNS, HE RECEIVED SEVERAL PHONE CALLS FROM A NUMBER THAT CAME UP "NO CALLER ID". MR. GARELICK ANSWERED THE PHONE AND THE CALLER SPOKE IN A ROBOTIC VOICE "IS THIS JASON? YOU'VE BEEN IN TOUCH WITH HACKERS. YOU AND THAT SPIC OFFICER LIVING NEXT TO YOU. YOU GUYS BETTER WATCH YOURSELVES." THE DESCRIPTION OF THE VOICE IN THIS CALL WAS SIMILAR TO THE CALL MR. QUEIRO RECEIVED ON 04/20/2023. MR. GARELICK REPORTED THIS INCIDENT TO HILLSDALE PD AND MR. QUEIRO STATED THAT HE ONLY WISHES TO HAVE THIS MATTER ON RECORD AND FOR ANY HARASSING CONTACT TO CEASE. PO LUSCOMBE AND MYSELF HAVE MADE TWO ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT THE RESIDENT AT 752 COLONIAL BLVD WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. THE BLACK CADILLAC CTS IS IN THE DRIVEWAY, HOWEVER THERE ARE NO LIGHTS ON IN THE HOUSE AND THE MAIL HAS NOT BEEN SITTING IN THE MAILBOX.
