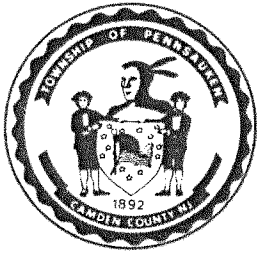
The Pennsauken Fire Department has no records responsive to your request.

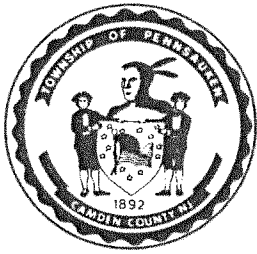

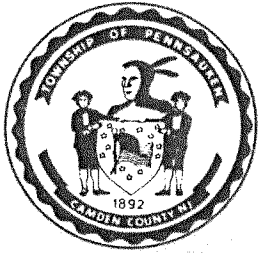
