On 7/21/2019 at 19:45 hours, I was dispatched to 141 Hamilton Street for a construction crane that fell. This address is a current construction site. I was in Unit 920.

Upon arrival, I observed said crane arm spanning across Hamilton Street resting on the roof of 142 Hamilton Street. The crane arm was still attached to the crane base. The crane arm continued passed the roof and struck the backside of 8 Condict Street and 10 Condict Street. Said addresses back up to 142 Hamilton Street. 8 Condict Street and 10 Condict Street were not occupied during the incident. 142 Hamilton Street was occupied by Kristin Andrascik. Andrascik was on the 2nd floor when this occurred. Andrascik was not injured but stated she was startled. 142 Hamilton Street did not have any other residents inside. EMS evaluated Andrascik, she declined further medical attention. There were no other known parties involved.

The fire department cleared 142 Hamilton Street and turned off the power. Captain Plowucha and Lieutenant Hilyer were present on scene. Detective Sabo arrived and processed the scene. The construction site foreman, Derrick Plunkett, was present on scene. PSE&G was present on scene.
