Upon arrival, I observed [redacted] laying on the bathroom floor. His breathing was very light and he was gargling. [redacted] friend. [redacted] had followed him into the store and checked on him in the bathroom as he believed he was going in there to use CDS.

I administered 2 mg of Nasal narkan which was deployed from vehicle #324 as well as an additional 4 mg dosage provided by the pharmacy. [redacted] then began to regain consciousness. Inside the bathroom I observed a hypodermic syringe under [redacted] body which was secured in a sharps container. There were also two (2) empty white wax paper folds stamped "Alien Rock" in black ink with a green and

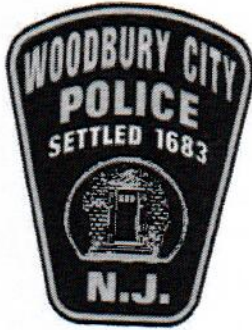

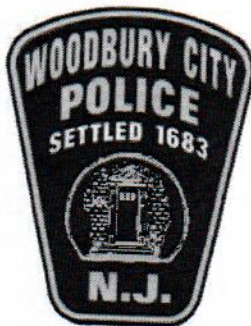

GCC advised Woodbury Units that [redacted] checked himself out of Inspira within minutes of being admitted.

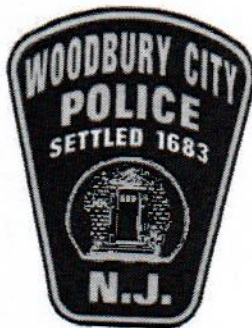

When she began feeling sick, she exited the bus at the North Broad Street bus stop where she later overdosed. [redacted] advised that she has overdosed several times in the past and most recently overdosed last night in Camden. [redacted] stated that her method of doing heroin varies between her snorting it and injecting with a needle. She could not provide the exact location in Camden where she purchased the heroin. Prior to being turned over to hospital staff [redacted] was provided some resources in hopes that it can assist with her addiction.

While on scene, there was no drug paraphernalia located in the immediate area. After returning to police headquarters, I completed a Naloxone Administration Reporting Form, which has been sent to NJSP and the GC Prosecutors Office. A copy of the form has also been submitted with this report. [redacted] has been flagged in ProPhoenix for a Narcan Deployment and the additional disposition for Naloxone has been added.

On 03/09/2019 at approximately 0104 hours I was dispatched to a New Jersey Transit (NJT) bus in the area of N Broad St. and Red Bank Ave for a report of a male passenger that was unconscious and unresponsive.

Upon my arrival the I got onto the NJT bus and observed a large white male later identified as blue in the face, unconscious and unresponsive. I immediately administered 2 mg of Naloxone into nose. While doing so Nurses from Inspira hospital and Gloucester County EMS (GCEMS) entered the bus and started giving oxygen. After a minute, I was showing no signs of improvement and I administered another 2 mg of Naloxone through nose. EMS and Nurses continued to give oxygen and was still not showing any signs of improvement. GCEMS then administered another 4

mg of Naloxone through nose and at that time . opened his eyes and regained a natural color in his face and was breathing on his own.

Shortly after was conscious and alert and was speaking with nurses and EMS. advised them that he snorted a half a bag of heroin. GCEMS then assisted John onto a stretcher and transported him to Inspira hospital.

Before clearing the scene I spoke with the bus driver, Brian Wisk who stated the following:

Brian stated he picked up from the bus stop at N Broad St and Watkins Ave at approximately 2330 hours and dropped him off at the bus stop at Broadway and Viola St in Camden. At approximately 0030 hours picked John back up at Broadway and Viola St. and transported him to the bus stop at N Broad St and Red Bank Ave when he noticed was unconscious and unresponsive. Being that the bus stop was close to the hospital, Brian went into the hospital to get help from the nurses and called 911.

After gathering all necessary information I cleared the scene.

Upon my arrival to police headquarters I completed the Gloucester County Naloxone Reporting form and faxed it to NJROIC. I also flagged in ProPhoenix as a suspected drug user and that he was administered Naloxone.

At approximately 4:30am I contacted the hospital and was advised that signed himself out of the hospital approximately 10 minutes after he arrived.

No further police action at this time.

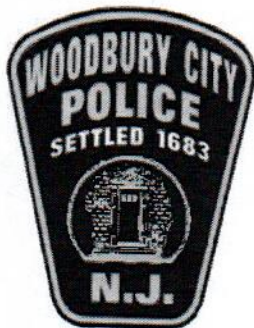

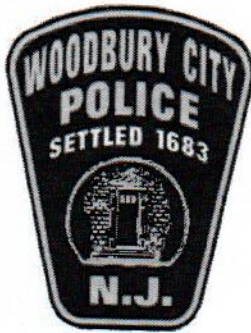

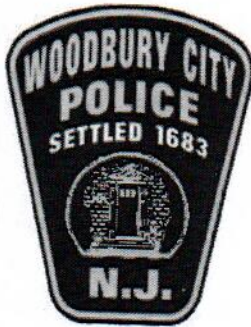
