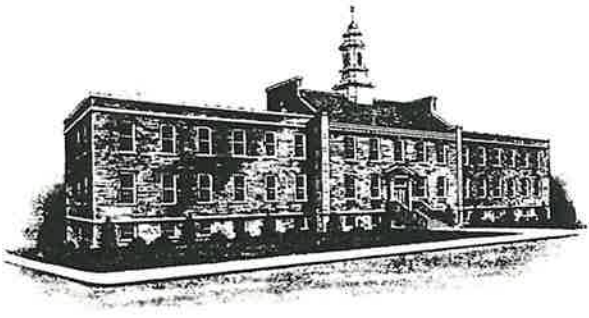

NARRATIVE

On 08/06/2009 at 17:41 Antoinette S. Maldari came into HQ to make a walk in report. She stated she previously rented a home at 15 Chesterfield Way. She stated she had problems in the past with her landlord John Milner and that on June 26 an Order to Evacuate the premises was posted. She stated she began moving her things out and left the home on

07/19/2009 but was rushed and had to leave some belongings behind in the home. She stated when she returned on 08/02/2009 to retrieve the last of her belongings the locks had been changed and she was unable to get into the home to retrieve several items. She stated that she called Mr. Milner several times but he hung up on her asking why she was "hassling" him. She stated she did eventually speak to Mr. Milner's mother who told her that her son "gave the items to Goodwill". She gave me a list of items which will be included with the case file. Some important items she listed were a rented trumpet from her child's school worth \$700.00, and 2 memory sticks containing lesson plans her boyfriend needs for his job as a teacher. No further police action taken by T/O at this time.
