The Ocean County Sheriff's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on or about 06-01-2021. The official Records Custodian, Lt. Adrian Bullock, received your OPRA request on 06-02-2021. Public Law 2020 c. 20 provides that during a period declared pursuant to the laws of this State as a state of emergency, public health emergency, or state of local disaster emergency, the deadlines by which to respond to a request for, or grant or deny access to, a government record under the Open Public Records Act shall not apply.
