FOR THE ROE STREET SOIL PILE REMOVAL

WHEREAS, the Borough of Haledon awarded a contract to The Ambient Group LLC, 222 Thies Road, Sewell New Jersey for the Roe Street Soil Pile removal; and

WHEREAS, Michael Cristaldi of the Alaimo Group has recommended that the Borough modify the award in his letter dated March 29, 2021 for Change Order No.1 decreasing the contract price by \$8,428.00 which results in a final contract amount of \$31,636.70 and further recommends the Borough pay \$31,636.70 in Current Estimate #1; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has concurred in the recommendation of Mr. Cristaldi and has determined that this Resolution should be adopted subject to the conditions hereinafter, stated;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Haledon as follows:

1. Change Order #1 is a decrease in the amount of \$8,428.00 that is due to final field quantity adjustments for unused items of work for a cumulative credit in the amount of \$8,428.00.
2. The modifications of the contract to provide for a change order reducing the contract price by \$8,428.00 for an amended contract amount of \$31,636.70.
3. Payment of \$31,636.70 to The Ambient Group LLC in accordance with the enclosed estimate.
4. The written concurrence by The Ambient Group LLC. to the modification shall be obtained in the form of Change Order No. 1, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
5. It is hereby determined that this Change Order does not expand the size, nature or scope of the project as it was originally described in the bid specifications. The work could not reasonably be effectuated by a separately bid contract without unduly disrupting the basic work or imposing adverse cost consequences.
6. The Contractor waives all claims for extensions of time and all claims for damages of whatsoever kind, either direct or indirect as well as any claim for impacted loss of profits of whatsoever kind related to this Change Order.

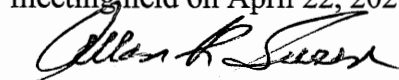

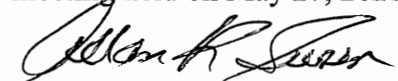

WHEREAS, for FY 2021, the Director authorizes the use of a three-year average for the calculation of affected revenues; and

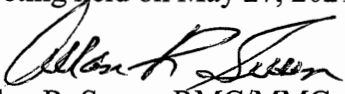

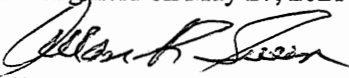

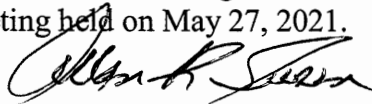

**TITLE:** RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE 2021 UDRIVE, UTEXT, UPAY  
DISTRACTED DRIVING CRACKDOWN APRIL 1-30, 2021

**WHEREAS**, distracted driving is a serious, life-threatening practice that is preventable; and

**WHEREAS** distracted driving can result in injuries and deaths to all road users (motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists); and

**WHEREAS**, distracted driving occurs when drivers divert their attention away from the task of driving to focus on another activity instead; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2018 alone distracted driving-related crashes resulted in 2,841 deaths and 400,000 injuries on our nation's roads; and

**WHEREAS**, in New Jersey distracted driving was listed as a contributing circumstance in 50-percent of all motor vehicle crashes in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, from 1619 to 1865, approximately 4,000,000 Africans and their descendants, under a practice that was constitutionally and statutorily sanctioned, were enslaved in the United States and the colonies that became the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the system of slavery that flourished in the United States constituted an immoral, shameful, and inhumane deprivation of the life, liberty, humanity, citizenship, and cultural heritage of Africans and also denied them, among other things, the fruits of their own labor upon which this country, and its economy, was built; and

**WHEREAS**, while many Northern states abolished slavery following the Civil War, New Jersey opposed the Emancipation Proclamation and was the last Northern state to abolish slavery. Following the Civil War, New Jersey refused to ratify the Reconstruction Amendments. New Jersey's deep roots in American slavery and its vestiges have endured to the present day; and

**WHEREAS**, the full effects of the institution and legacy of slavery on Black people and communities in New Jersey have not been sufficiently examined, nor have there been remedies for past injustice and present harm, or sufficient efforts at transformation. As a result of historic and continued systemic racial discrimination, Black people in New Jersey confront some of the worst racial disparities in America, including but not limited to Access to Democracy, Youth Justice, the Housing and the Racial Wealth Gap and Racial Segregation; and

**WHEREAS**, to address these systemic challenges in New Jersey, the "New Jersey Reparations Task Force" will research, write, and publish a report that will make the case for State-based reparations in New Jersey and outline policy recommendations that seek to repair the harm that has resulted from America's original sin in the Garden State; and

**WHEREAS**, it shall be the duty of the "New Jersey Reparations Task Force" to study and develop reparations proposals for Black people in this State.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HALEDON** that the historic wrong of slavery in New Jersey and its impacts on our modern society must be fully studied to develop reparations proposals for Black people in the State of New Jersey and it supports the creation of a New Jersey Reparations Task Force now proposed in Bill S322 sponsored by Senator Ronald Rice and Bill A711 sponsored by Assemblywoman Shavonda Sumter and co-sponsored by Assemblyman Benjie Wimberly.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Municipal Council of the Borough of Haledon urges the Senate President and the Assembly Speaker to advance these bills for consideration by the respective House of the New Jersey Legislature.

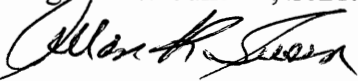
