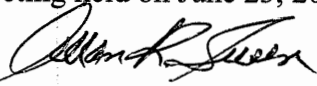
WHEREAS, the Borough of Haledon Tax Collector and Chief Financial Officer has computed an estimated tax levy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3, and they have signed a certification showing the tax levies for the previous year, the tax rates and the range of permitted estimated tax levies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Haledon, in the County of Passaic, and State of New Jersey on this 23rd day of June, 2022, as follows:

1. The Borough of Haledon Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Borough for the third installment of 2022 taxes.
2. The entire estimated tax levy for 2022 is hereby set at \$25,321,004.00 and the estimated tax rate set at \$4.998.
3. In accordance with law the third installment of 2022 taxes shall not be subject to interest until the later of August 11 or the twenty-fifth calendar day after the date the estimated tax bills are mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date on which interest may begin to accrue.

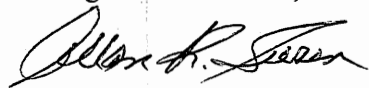
