- Haledon Ave./Belmont Ave.

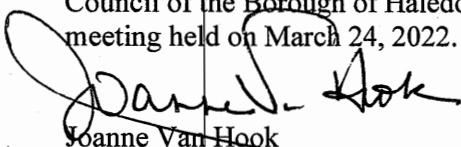

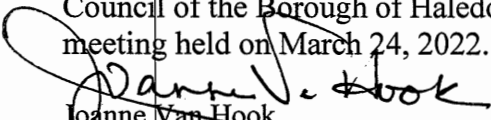

WHEREAS, this premise changed with the inception of Chapter 2 of P.L. 2010 requiring employees to pay a percentage of their premium; and

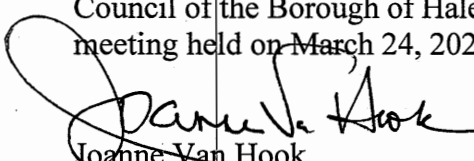
WHEREAS, this requirement alone may cause employees that have coverage elsewhere to waive their insurance without the need for a financial incentive; and
