Last evening I received the below letter from David Frank, Esq. In the letter, Mr. Frank expresses his displeasure that I did not provide him with notice of my intention to object to the Resolution, demands that I withdraw my objection and threatens to file a baseless complaint on the grounds that I breached a contract to which I am not party. Mr. Frank's demands are in violation of my civil rights and rights afforded under the Open Public Meeting Act and other laws enacted by the New Jersey Legislature to protect citizens of the State of New Jersey.
