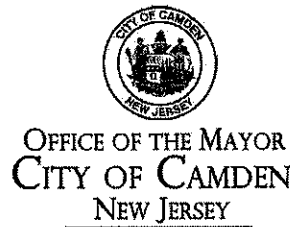

*****OFFICIAL STATEMENT*****

CAMDEN, NJ – The City of Camden is supportive of the need to preserve the property located at 753 Walnut Street and we continue to investigate the availability of private and public resources in an effort to stabilize and provide an appropriate use for this property.

The City has been working with Ms. Hunt, Patrick Duff, State, elected officials and Coopers Ferry Partnership to move this project forward. While Cooper's Ferry Partnership (CFP) has applied for CDBG funding, the City has not awarded these funds to CFP because the State historic designation and MLK licensing are not final. We are confident that once the issues are resolved, we will work with the stakeholders and the community to develop a long-term strategy for the property's stabilization and programming.

As we work through these necessary steps, the Camden County Historical Society has committed to install historic markers in the vicinity of the property that will speak to the historic significance of the neighborhood. Additionally, the City's Department of Planning and Development will collaborate with CFP and other local community development organizations to develop a neighborhood and a redevelopment plan for this important cultural neighborhood enclave as a historical center of place.
