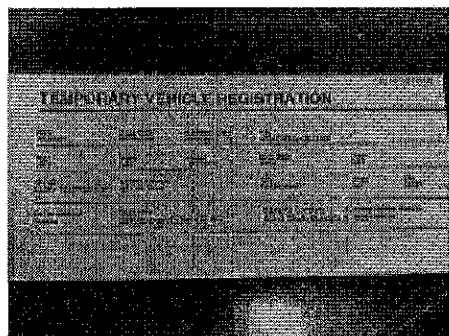

Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Committee, Veronica and Chief DiBella,

As you are all well aware our organization was challenged to fulfill its mission. In 2015 I understand (and rightfully so) the town as about to step in and take appropriate action to be sure the residents and visitors of Lacey Township were cared for during a medical or other emergency requiring an ambulance response. As we are all now aware Lacey Township EMS is one of the last all volunteer EMS agencies in the state of New Jersey that answers over 2,000 calls per year and is all volunteer. Combine Lacey and Lanoka's call volume and we are absolutely the **only all-volunteer** agencies that covers one jurisdiction responding to nearly 3,000 calls for service per year in the state of New Jersey.

Because of your patience, understanding, support and most importantly the trust you have placed in me, my leadership team our EMT's and Responders I'm proud to report that we are set up for another successful year in 2018. Our newest ambulance went on the road today and responded to its first call. Our second rig will be going out within a week or so to be refurbished and we expect it to be in service before Mother Day's 2018. We are in the business of caring for and transporting people. A well running, new vehicle is critical to the care of those we are called to assist and **without all of your support it would not have been possible.**

In 2018 it is our goal to continue to use Bamber Lakes as we have been and in a greater capacity to give the town the biggest bang for its tax dollar. We have already met with the new Station 60 Chief Scotty and are laying down plans for mutual aid responses and how we can both work more closely with Chief DiBella and his team if a large scale incident were to occur within Lacey. Finally, we are very pleased with Lanoka Harbor's turn-around in 2017 and anticipate them performing to a similar level in 2018. This will allow us to continue to break down barriers built by our predecessors and provide Lacey with an even better service level in 2018.

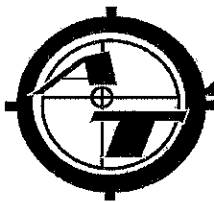

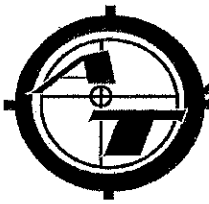

I would like to sincerely thank each of you for your support in 2017. Words cannot express how much the trust in allowing me to use tax payer's dollars means to me. I consider it an honor and a privilege. Thank you for your time last night.

I do understand the power plant closure will result in decreased revenue. I have taken the reduced tax revenue into consideration while making my requests.

Please know what I'm about to say is not a perverted attempt to manipulate feelings or capitalize on the enormous loss our country feels when an incident occurs. I was devastated to learn of another school shooting but I'm hopeful this time will be different. Another school incident occurred yesterday in Jackson Ohio.

I appreciate and agree with your feedback regarding billing. Like I said I would absolutely like to recover costs and with help we can make that a reality. If the governing body would consider granting my requests I would have no problem entering into an agreement to refund the town for the 2018 cap-x requests once we got billing off the ground and revenue started coming in. It will take almost two years for billing to begin and revenue to start flowing in.

Each agency and interest in town is vying for tax dollars and every agency and department coming together as a whole is what makes Lacey Township great. However, public safety is the only agency where people's lives are saved or lost.

We all pray, worry and hope an incident similar to what occurred at Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland Florida doesn't occur in Lacey Township. I could go on with a long list, but you're all familiar with mass shootings and how sadly common they have become. Very few department heads carry the immense burden of wondering if their agency is prepared and equipped to handle a similar incident. I would say there are three people who carry the heaviest part of this burden and that is, Chief DiBella, Matt Bender and me. What makes carrying this burden even more difficult is, as we prepare our agencies for an event that is statistically to not occur, we also have to absorb potential push back for costs associated with planning and preparing for any communities worse day. However, every public safety head said "not in my town, it could never happen here"; and then, it did. I will tell you my single biggest fear in my life is an incident that occurs in Lacey that we aren't prepared and equipped for.

As the frequency of these incidents evolves so too does the public safety response. Once was a time when law enforcement surrounded, contained and waited for "SWAT." Once was a time when EMS parked two miles down the road held at bay by law enforcement as children bled out only to be called in hours later after those that were waiting for help died. Law enforcement and EMS have evolved. My people's role in these incidents has changed as we continue to communicate, drill and work with Chief DiBella. With law enforcements approval I would not sit on the sideline waiting. I would have no problem putting my personal safety at

risk if it meant getting one kid or citizen out of harm's way and get them the help they need to potentially save their life. I know a large number of my people would do the same.

I've surveyed my people privately and 73% of my people would go into a "warm zone" which is characterized as a building/area/scene that poses a significant and credible risk to life but the threat is believed to be contained without guarantee of personal safety. I believe when put to the task 20% of my people that said they would enter a warm zone would change their mind and opt choose a passive vs. active role when reality stares them in the face. This leaves me with approximately 20 people who I know would enter a warm zone and work with law enforcement in caring for and evacuating the injured in an effort to minimize loss of life even if it meant at risk to their own life.

I realize at first glance the idea of purchasing bullet resistant vests and helmets may sound absurd. Asking for two vehicles after just purchasing us two sounds like a lot. My hope is that by sharing this with you tonight you continue to understand what we do and how we have evolved. We are unpaid people who may one day be thrust into a situation that most would run from. I can't pay my people, but at the least I want to protect them and be sure they are equipped appropriately.

You are all now aware of how much my squad does in the way of answering calls, man hours and the service levels that we provide. I don't need to rehash these with you. What I am here to ask you for tonight is your continued support and to help me prepare for worst case scenario. If the worst never happens then we will excel handling the smaller things. If the worst does occur we can all say in complete truth we prepared to the best of our ability and did everything we could to mitigate loss of life.

It is my intention in 2018 to continue to use donations and the little savings we have to continue to prepare for the little and big things. Additional specialty equipment to handle multiple shooting victims, costly training known as Tactical Combat Casualty Care for my responders who are statistically most likely to encounter mass casualties secondary to violence and a multitude of other supplies many of you never imagined we carried. I ask that you relieve me of my capital expenditure costs so I don't have to spend money on vehicle repairs or attempting to finance vehicles and other expenses so I can focus on operations and preparing for a day that I hope never comes.

I realize purchasing a new utility truck to the tune of approximately \$40,000 is expensive. Please know it is my intention to hand my current captain's truck down that the squad paid for and turn it into a first responder truck replacing our enormous Excursion. I would then take this truck as the Captains truck. Our current Excursion is too large to navigate in tight spaces and is **thirteen years old**. It's not properly configured and to bring it up to standard would be cost

prohibitive. It plays an important role in our fleet and drastically reduces response times to urgent calls.

I can't thank each of you enough for funding the remount of two of our ambulances. I fully realize asking for a third may raise an eye brow. I wouldn't ask for something I didn't need. I was hoping I could delay asking for a third vehicle until 2019. Unfortunately, I just sank \$3,000 into this vehicle a month ago and it needs another \$2,000 worth of work in the next month or two. It is seven years old and rapidly showing its age. I don't want to be in the position of putting it out of service because we can't afford to repair it. Please keep in mind \$5,000 is **about 10% of all the cash we currently have on hand**. I must have three well running ambulances or we run the risk of being short a rig or putting too much of a strain on the other two ambulances. Every dollar I spend on fixing an ambulance is another dollar diverted from operating costs. It isn't a want, it's a genuine need.

Finally, our blacktop is literally crumbling and in some spots we are down to dirt. We have patched and re-patched so many times it looks like a quilt. We cannot possibly afford it but we need new blacktop all the way around the building. I was provided a quote for \$40,000 for the blacktop. Our roof has a leak and it is time to replace it. Again, the cost associated with a new roof would take a significant portion of our savings.

Lacey EMS is the **last** all volunteer agency answering 2,000 calls per year left in the county and one of a few in the state. As you consider my requests please know we are operating on the same annual contribution and the same annual donations for **decades**. If you could assist me in granting my capital expense requests I can figure out how to manage operating costs.

If you feel items have to be cut from my request please cut the roof and driveway. I can put buckets on the floor to catch rain drops and ignore the crumbling blacktop. Your support is truly appreciated and I was honored to appear before all of you last night.

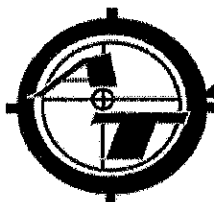

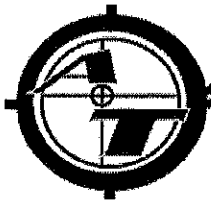

Hi,

To better explain. We are approaching the 11th hour; we have a few more t's to cross. We scheduled the state inspection for August 27th. All is well and today out of no where a female who identified herself as an attorney for the state called me and immediately began interrogating me. It felt like a deposition.

As I mentioned the plan is to license two vehicles just like Lanoka, South Toms River and many other agencies in the county have. That's generally understood how organizations transition from no license and no billing to state licensed and billing. I need to keep the one volunteer rig so I can continue to use a driver and EMT as needed. On the state licensed rigs there must be two EMT's (no more driver and an EMT). I don't quite have the staffing for that but as we progress and start paying 12/7, then 24/7 then a second rig 12/7 more revenue means I can staff two ambulances with paid staff. I wouldn't be able to right away since billing proceeds will be slow to start.

The attorney drilled me on thing such as: How do I know I'll generate enough money to cover salary (we will - we analyzed it with Cornerstone), the attorney kept stressing this is doomed to fail and she has seen it time and time again. Everything I tried to speak she would cut me off and shut me down. She had an agenda before I even answered the phone. I explained that billing revenue will cover salary and then as we get our feet under us operating costs. I further explained, the Township of Lacey is fully on-board and is fully aware of all my plans. She considered that highly suspect and began asking for a detailed business plan with all possible nuances accounted for. Then came the concern of having two state licensed rigs and one volunteer rig. Her concern was that we may use the volunteer rig to bill patients (never happen). I stressed the volunteer rig would be labeled "Lacey Township Volunteer First Aid" and Lacey First Aid is the corporation and Lacey Township Emergency Medical Services is the DBA.

Chris Tams and Felicia Whipkey are the people who are responsible for issuing the licenses and inspections. They fully knew what the plans were and gave the head nod back in May. They are reasonable and supportive; whoever this attorney appears to have stepped all over their toes.

So, I'm going to send them an email and I will copy you and connect you. This way, any shadow of doubt can be removed. They indicated a letter stating you authorize us to do this, that you will provide material support such as fuel, insurance, access to counsel for consultations, accounting/finance advice and capital expenditures, as the budget allows would be helpful. Chris and Felicia just want to make sure if a new Mayor comes into office next year he doesn't step in and shut it down. Their goal is continuity of care without disrupting services.

The attorney call no idea where it came from, it was so adversarial in nature that I'm sure it was prompted by someone. Someone who perhaps has connections and suggested there is no way I can successfully manage to pull this off.

Evening Chris and Felicia,

I've copied Veronica Laureigh on this note. Veronica is the townships long term Administrator who is responsible for the day to day operations of the town, administering the budget and recommends actions for the health and safety of the township.

Thank you for taking the time to speak to me after our initial call. I did brief Veronica on the first call with the attorney regarding her line of questions, aggressive and unnecessary adversarial approach. As well as our more productive and pleasant follow up call with just the three of us.

As I understand our conversation today some of your concerns are:

- The township switching gears when a new governing body lands in office and shuts down Lacey Emergency Medical Services causing a disruption to EMS services within Lacey.
- You would like confirmation that I have fully involved all stakeholders within the township and made them aware of my plans including law enforcement and OEM.
- You would like confirmation the township supports my plan to license two ambulances, begin soft billing health insurance and begin transitioning into a stand alone paid EMS provider in the township of Lacey. Also, to begin ASAP even if it means borrowing a small sum or using our savings to address the urgent staffing issue that will be upon us in October of 2019.
- Confirmation the plan and necessity through natural attrition and management to phase out drivers and only have fully qualified EMT's staffing three licensed ambulances.
 - With the understanding people can still volunteer and not be paid but everyone regardless of paid or volunteer will be held to the same standards. With only 6 drivers I anticipate this being completed by Q4 2019.
 - This will allow for ample time for those who are interested to secure their EMT certification.
- You would like confirmation the township will continue to provide material support such as fuel, insurance, capital expenditures such as vehicles and other cap-x items as the budget allows.
- The township will continue to support us with an annual donation.
- We will have access and support to key information and resources such as financial budget advice, CPA guidance, access to township legal counsel and other critical consultative resources.
- From the first call I assume some testimony regarding my business acumen and management skill set may be helpful.

If I'm forgetting anything please let me know. I'm hoping we can all connect and Veronica can provide you with the documentation and assurance you are looking for.

I'm hoping you can act as my advocate and give me some latitude as I learn. It's my intent to make Lacey Township Emergency Medical Services the example and standard of transitioning from all volunteer unlicensed to licensed all paid staff without being an additional burden on the tax payers.

Attached please find out monthly report. An update on our progress, state of EMS in the community as well as surrounding communities.

Lacey EMS:

- Our call volume is increasing, most notably are the incidences of back to back calls from midnight to 6:00AM. As an example, last week we had three separate calls dispatched within ten minutes at about 1:30AM. I anticipate reaching 2300 calls by EOY. Of those 2300 I project 1700 or so will be transports.
- We are just barely holding on with staffing but I anticipate that challenge being resolved very shortly (see below).
- Our house is coming together nicely. With the driveway repair, cement repair and clean up/maintenance its coming together nicely. The last thing I'd like to do before winter is get the roof repaired. It's a small section of roofing that is above the living quarters area. If the town could provide the labor we can purchase the supplies; hopefully, before winter.
- As you know we passed state inspection. We now have two licensed trucks that requires two EMT's at all times. The third rig will still be able to used as a driver/EMT combination. I anticipate licensing that vehicle by Q3 2019, if not sooner.
- The state of NJ is processing our paperwork to be a non-profit employer and I anticipate that license being issued shortly.
- We signed our contacts with Cornerstone (the cost recovery company) and will be hosting training's later this week to get everyone up to speed.
- We are going to go with the same payroll company the town uses and are in final steps to sign off on that.
- We are shooting for September the third week of September to go live on billing health insurance.
- I'm expecting the first pay period to be October 1st - October 14th

Lacey Township:

- Chief DiBella seems very happy and interested in the steps we've taken.
- I haven't heard much from Lanoka in a while but other than the day of can shaking at Shop Rite then not having a crew an hour later all is quiet on the western front.

Surrounding communities:

- Bayville EMS appears to be struggling and now has the paid Berkeley 55 (The paid service that covers Holiday City) in 2-3 days per week. Also, on multiple occasions a rig has to respond from Holiday City to the furthers points in Bayville.

- Waretown EMS: Holding steady with being volunteer evenings and weekends with QMT covering other times.
- Barnegat EMS: Continuing to erode despite being covered by QMT similar to Waretown.
- Ocean Gate: Not getting it done at all. Not even sure how the exist anymore.
- Beachwood: Having more and more trouble providing service. Hanging on but getting worse.
- Stafford: Hanging on with QMT assisting.
- South Toms River: Starting to struggle and will be bringing QMT in to support.

The long and the short of it is (and i'm proud to say) we will be the only community in the entire area that will have a self sustaining EMS service that is not provided by a police department or OEM.

As always, thank you for the support and confidence in us.

Re: An open message to my fellow first responders

This week is a very special week to me and it should be equally special to all of you. Three years ago, it was our *darkest hour*. **Patients were waiting twenty, thirty and even forty minutes for an ambulance.** Mutual aid was coming as far away as Stafford Township and South Toms River. Our law enforcement officers were frustrated as valuable resources were tied up waiting for an ambulance to show up instead of performing law enforcement functions. I often say the Police Department doesn't ask us to give tickets or arrest bad guys; don't ask them to do our job. It was socially acceptable to be scheduled for a shift and if you had to call out, send out a message and hope someone covered it. If someone didn't cover you still called out and there wasn't an ambulance that day; no one was held accountable. The defense often used was "I'm a volunteer" somehow making that more ok. I wonder if the person and their family waiting for an ambulance thought *"I know it's been twenty-five minutes, but their volunteers, it's ok."* Morale was at an all-time low, fighting within the organization was rampant and our house was filthy and filled with outdated hand me down furniture and electronics. Responders were told they need to answer calls **and** clean toilets if they want a clean house and trash cans were commonly found overflowing on to the floor with a sink full of dirty dishes. Our vehicles were aging and things like CPAP, EPI, ASA, safe helmets, CATs and legitimate trauma supplies were not available. In fact, we ordered the least expensive everything even if it meant it was poor quality. We didn't have a medical director and our ready room contained an old wooden counter and a couple small Rubbermaid cabinets. Responders were told ice packs were being stolen and therefore only a few at a time would be put out (by the way, if you need ice packs for your home or any other reason feel free to take some – just let me know so I can replace them). Uniforms consisted of a cheap t-shirt and a hoodie. New responders came on-board and they were often handed a used t-shirt or sweatshirt as their uniform. Some leadership barely acknowledged fellow responders when they entered the house and cliques were abound. Every business meeting was filled with sarcastic comments, tension and arguments. I specifically remember a meeting where someone wanted to buy crayons for kids coloring books as a giveaway at events. An argument ensued that we shouldn't spend the money on crayons; rather we should gather crayons from home and use those to give out to save money. Every December people jockeyed for leadership positions just so they could have a title even though they lacked the leadership, people or business skills to be effective in their roles. The township was seeking alternatives such as having QMT come in and take over and at the time a large majority of our calls were being answered by MONOC BLS. The township was within thirty days of shutting us down.

For three years we have answered over 99% of our first rig calls and in most cases second rig calls. Our house is in order inside and out. Every few months we see new and improved coming in the door for us, our patients and the betterment of the organization. We have received more assets and support from the town in three years than we ever have with more to come. We are respected by law enforcement and to the astonishment of many, highly successful. We are fulfilling the mission and our responders take pride in what we do. We are the only agency left in the county and one of very few in the state that can boast over a 99% first rig response w/o mutual aid that answers **over 2,000** calls per year. **Hate us or love us, many organizations wish they could be us.** We now have two of our vehicles licensed by the state. By November every vehicle we have including supervisor vehicles except 238 will have less than 15,000 miles on them. Even our oldest vehicle (238) will have a make-over at minimal cost to us. Our rebranding is almost complete. We have the very best equipment and no expense is spared with patient care. Our responders are outfitted with the best uniforms and our vehicles are now on a pro-active preventative maintenance schedule. Brakes won't be replaced when we hear a "noise" they will be replaced on a schedule. Tires no longer get eye balled they get measured with a tread depth tool and will be replaced before minimums. We have a process and procedure for managing critical elements of the "business" and things keep getting better. Did you know when bad weather hit responders were told to take the oldest vehicle in the fleet (the old 237) that was fifteen years old? I suppose in case there was an accident it would have the least impact on the fleet. I believe when it snows you should take the newest and safest vehicle in the fleet to be sure you and your patient are safe, and you come home. You're more important to me than an asset.

Cost recovery and subsequently compensating for human resources will be instrumental in providing a higher level of service to the community and making our time here even better. Our being proactive and managing our own future will ensure Lacey Township EMS will be a success story to be modeled after by many. True, many things will change. Yes, you will have to wear your uniform, you will be required to attend mandatory trainings and you will do a rig check every shift while being stationed at quarters. Yes, your charts will be done differently, and they will be completed prior to shift end. However, if you qualify you will be compensated for your time. Currently our house is in the best condition it's ever been in. However, I won't settle. I know we can do better for ourselves and for the community.

I envision an organization where we continue enjoy each other's company, spend quality time with each and where every person who chooses to be on-board and immerse themselves in our culture as a strong contributor is welcome and counts each of us as a friend. Expectations and accountability will certainly increase; and that's ok, it's better for you, us and the community. What was acceptable three years ago is culturally unacceptable today. What was acceptable yesterday may not be acceptable tomorrow. Adaptation is critical; if you can't or won't adapt you will likely fall behind and eventually be left behind. **As your leader I will always help someone reach for the bar, but I will never lower the bar, ever.**

There will be some growing pains. The road ahead has challenges and obstacles we haven't even thought of. Occasionally some of our peers may not agree with every decision or may feel the organization is changing too rapidly. It's ok to feel that way and in fact it's a normal reaction to change. I will always do my best to be considerate of everyone's feelings and to be as inclusive as possible. However, progress will not stop or slow for anyone for any reason. The mission, responsibility and trust placed in all of us will always come first.

It won't be easy and there will be many bumps in the road. However, I can't imagine a hill higher than the one we climbed in the 2015/2016. Therefore, I have every confidence we will emerge bigger, better, stronger and faster. The next few months will be filled with challenges, successes, mistakes and changes. There is no group of people anywhere that I would rather face the future with than all of you. I hold the trust each of you place in me dearly and I will continue to honor that trust by giving 100% and expecting 100% from each of you.

New Jersey Earned Sick Leave

Notice of Employee Rights

Under New Jersey's Earned Sick Leave Law, most employees have a right to accrue up to 40 hours of earned sick leave per year. Go to nj.gov/labor to learn which employees are covered by the law.

New employees must receive this written notice from their employer when they begin employment, and existing employees must receive it by November 29, 2018. Employers must also post this notice in a conspicuous and accessible place at all work sites, and provide copies to employees upon request.

YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO EARNED SICK LEAVE.

Amount of Earned Sick Leave

Your employer must provide up to a total of 40 hours of earned sick leave every benefit year. Your employer's benefit year is:

Start of Benefit Year: _____ End of Benefit Year: _____

Rate of Accrual

You accrue earned sick leave at the rate of 1 hour for every 30 hours worked, up to a maximum of 40 hours of leave per benefit year. Alternatively, your employer can provide you with 40 hours of earned sick leave up front.

Date Accrual Begins

You begin to accrue earned sick leave on October 29, 2018, or on your first day of employment, whichever is later.

Exception: If you are covered by a collective bargaining agreement that was in effect on October 29, 2018, you begin to accrue earned sick leave under this law beginning on the date that the agreement expires.

Date Earned Sick Leave is Available for Use

You can begin using earned sick leave accrued under this law 120 days after you begin employment.

Acceptable Reasons to Use Earned Sick Leave

You can use earned sick leave to take time off from work when:

- You need diagnosis, care, treatment, or recovery for a mental or physical illness, injury, or health condition; or you need preventive medical care.
- You need to care for a **family member** during diagnosis, care, treatment, or recovery for a mental or physical illness, injury, or health condition; or your family member needs preventive medical care.
- You or a family member **have been the victim of domestic violence or sexual violence** and need time for treatment, counseling, or to prepare for legal proceedings.
- You need to attend **school-related conferences, meetings, or events** regarding your child's education; or to attend a school-related meeting regarding your child's health.
- Your employer's business **closes due to a public health emergency** or you need to care for a child whose school or child care provider closed due to a public health emergency.

Family Members

The law recognizes the following individuals as "family members:"

- Child (biological, adopted, or foster child; stepchild; legal ward; child of a domestic partner or civil union partner)
- Grandchild
- Sibling
- Spouse
- Domestic partner or civil union partner
- Parent
- Grandparent
- Spouse, domestic partner, or civil union partner of an employee's parent or grandparent
- Sibling of an employee's spouse, domestic partner, or civil union partner
- Any other individual related by blood to the employee
- Any individual whose close association with the employee is the equivalent of family

Advance Notice

If your need for earned sick leave is foreseeable (can be planned in advance), your employer can require up to 7 days' advance notice of your intention to use earned sick leave. If your need for earned sick leave is unforeseeable (cannot be planned in advance), your employer may require you to give notice as soon as it is practical.

Documentation

Your employer can require reasonable documentation if you use earned sick leave on 3 or more consecutive work days, or on certain dates specified by the employer. The law prohibits employers from requiring your health care provider to specify the medical reason for your leave.

Unused Sick Leave

Up to 40 hours of unused earned sick leave can be carried over into the next benefit year. However, your employer is only required to let you use up to 40 hours of leave per benefit year. Alternatively, your employer can offer to purchase your unused earned sick leave at the end of the benefit year.

You Have a Right to be Free from Retaliation for Using Earned Sick Leave

Your employer cannot retaliate against you for:

- Requesting and using earned sick leave

Retaliation includes any threat, discipline, discharge, demotion, suspension, or reduction in hours, or any other adverse employment action against you for exercising or attempting to exercise any right guaranteed under the law.

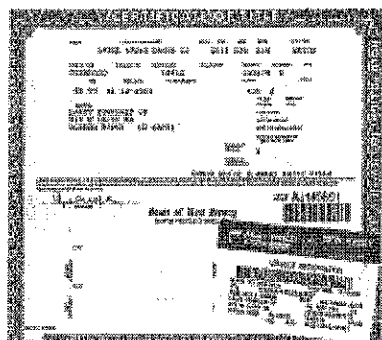

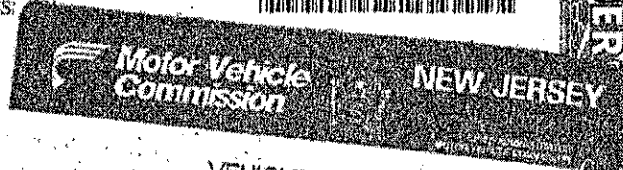

A heads up for you and the team. I realize you and your team very often have your backs against the wall when trying to find resources to handle EMS calls throughout the county. It's an insurmountable challenge and unfortunate so many communities haven't taken proactive steps to rectify the lack of EMS coverage within their communities.

As you know Lacey has consistently provided timely responses over the past three years and with Lacey EMS converting to paid staff we will ensure the highest quality of care and expedient response times in years to come.

Unfortunately, we don't have endless resources and for as much as I'd like to backup other jurisdictions as well as contracted services like QMT we don't have the resources and our first obligation is to the residents and visitors of Lacey Township.

I've advised my people they cannot accept over the air assignments outside of the mutual aid plan unless it's a priority life threat call. We will of course continue to honor currently placed mutual aid agreements. However, I can't have one of my units handling a general weakness in Barnegat or an intoxicated subject in South Toms River because they just happen to be returning from CMC or SOCM. I stress, if a life threat call goes out and one of my units are closest please call on them to handle the job. It's morally and ethically the right thing to do.

Your team does a great job and I understand their trying to get the calls answered. I've reached out to a variety of agencies within Southern Ocean County offering my services, expertise and advice in how they can improve their organizations in an effort to improve EMS coverage within the county. As of now, not one agency has accepted my offer of help. If you know of agencies looking for help feel free to give them my contact info.

Veronica,

Please pass my thank you along to the Mayor and Committee for their support over the past few years. As our service levels and commitment to the community continue to rise so to will our need our need for maintaining our assets and reliable vehicles.

Currently ambulance 238 is 8 years old and will be due for replacement at the end of 2019. If we don't replace 238 next year this would put its replacement into Q4 2020.

Because of the questionable future with Lanoka EMS I have to plan for handling more calls in 2019. Currently Lacey EMS handles 2200-2250 calls annually and the requests for service is increasing every year. If Lacey EMS handles 50% of Lanoka's call volume in 2019 that would put our call volume over 2800 calls per year.

Also, four of our AED's are approaching ten years old and reaching end of life.

I'd respectfully request the following two budget items:

- Remount 238 - Cost effective solution vs. buying brand new. A meager increase of approximately \$2,000 over 2016 prices. Remounting the previous two vehicles and this vehicles we have realized a total savings of \$150,000 over three years by remounting vehicles.
 - \$131,866
- Replace four aging AED's
 - \$2803.00 each
 - Total of \$11,212.00

Hope it was good.

Think we should address this sooner than later. It seems to be occurring with much greater frequency. Today I have crews playing Monopoly and watching Netflix while calls (three calls) in Lanoka wait to go unanswered by Lanoka then we get the mutual aid dispatch. Then after the delay and we are dispatched we get up and respond. It seems very silly to me, we should be working not playing Monopoly while someone waits for an ambulance. This is not to say we won't ever need help because we will, but in three years we have NEVER lost a single first rig call even when we weren't paid.

Today it appears Lanoka just abandoned ship for Christmas. We've given them two years, I think that's more than fair.

My recommendation would be:

- 1) No more time, no more chances to fix it. We can't keep doing this everytime leadership is about to change and then give the new leader a year to fix it.
- 2) They man their station with a crew at quarters twelve hours per day from 0600-1800 seven days a week. We also did this 65-70% of the time when we were all volunteer, so yes it can be done. They should be able to handle 1800-0600.
- 3) Anytime they dont have a crew at the station 0600-1800 calls would automatically go to 23.
- 3) Second rig calls would automatically go to Lacey regardless of time. I will work to staff up to this for optimal response times.
- 4) From 1800-0600 Lanoka would respond from home in a timely fashion. Timely being rig out the door in less than 8 minutes.
- 6) Anytime 23 is on, no line officers or members responding to calls in personal vehicles or first responder trucks. You're either on or your not, no recreational dabbling when the "glory" call goes out.

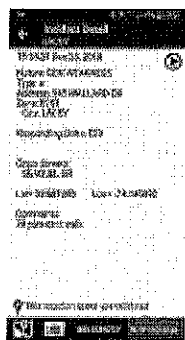
Dual dispatch does not work. It creates confusion, aggravation and dangerous games of people trying to "beat" the other agency to the call. We also tried getting them to do the schedule and they played games with it. Part of the agreement was they were to notify me when they don't have a crew. I have NEVER received notice when they don't have a crew.

If they want to figure out a way to have paid staff then good for them and good for the community. I'd support that move if they can manage it effectively and legally. In the meantime no one should wait for an ambulance while we play board games and watch Netflix.

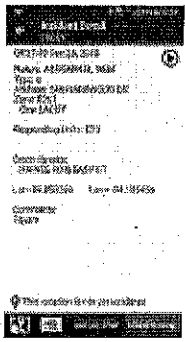
Whatever you and the governing body decide you have our full commitment and support. We can be ready to start helping January 1st and staff up to the service levels I expect (rigs out the door in two minutes or less) by February 14th latest.

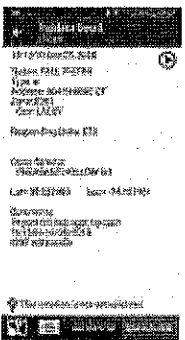
