- Whereas:** Realizing the urgent need for organ and tissue donors across the country, the **NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH** observance promotes a greater understanding about the life-saving benefits of donation and transplantation. Moreover, the need is increasing. NJ Sharing Network - who in 2018 is celebrating 30 years of saving lives - is committed to addressing that need through increased awareness; and
- Whereas:** The transplantation of organs and tissue is a miracle of modern medicine made possible through the compassion of organ and tissue donors, enabling surgeons to save thousands of lives every year. One organ donor can save eight lives and one tissue donor can restore health to over 75 others.
