By email dated April 5, 2023 you submitted the following OPRA request:

Please provide me with all investigative materials from the 11-13-2009 police complaint regarding underage sex and drinking at Joe Andl's residence. Please provide all written reports and also any evidence collected during the investigation.

The Township responds as follows:

To clarify, the Township provided Incident Report 2009-15240 in response to your OPRA request for complaints regarding 112 E. Park Avenue, Maple Shade; this document was not provided in response to your request for complaints referencing Joe Andl.

As to your above request, there are no documents responsive to this request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Maple Shade Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
