NARRATIVE

On Tuesday January 25, 2022 at approximately 1707 hours patrols were dispatched to 56 Hancock Street for the report of a noise complaint. While in route County dispatched advised that the caller from 58 Hancock Street would like to speak with an officer. Upon arrival to 58 Hancock Street, I was met by the callers Baira and Vladislav who invited me into their residence, advising that the neighbor at 56 Hancock Street is playing loud music which is disturbing them. While speaking with the caller it should be noted that from where I was in the residence I was unable to hear the music.

Baira and Vladislav were advised of my observation, at which time they were asked if the music was turned off. Vladislav stated "No" inviting me further into the residence, now in the dinning room, where he stated he could still hear it. Once in the dinning room a faint thumping

noise could barely be heard, which at my discretion I did not feel police action needed to be taken. Baira and Vladislav were both explained the process of signing a complaint with the Court Administrator and that I would be responding to 56 Hancock Street to speak with the accused.

Baira stated that they have a court hearing tomorrow for the same thing. Baira and Vladislav were advised contact police if the level of the music is raised and that I would be completing a report to document this incident. It was recommended to them to advise the Judge of this incident tomorrow when their in court. After speaking with Baira and Vladislav I responded to 56 Hancock Street to speak with the accused party. Upon arrival I was met by Jahmere Holliday who was leaving his residence for work. I spoke to Jahmere briefly as he was walking to his vehicle advising him of the complaints made by his neighbor. Jahmere admitted he was playing his music but it wasn't loud. Jahmere was then advised that there could be charges pending, at which point he stated they have court for this same type of incident tomorrow.

It was explained to Jahmere that a report would be completed and that he should refrain from listening to loud music, at least until they go to court. After receiving all information from Jahmere, units were clear.

No further police action was taken at this time, more information to follow if and when received.
