NARRATIVE

On the date of March 19th, 2022 at approximately 1648hrs, Logan Patrols received a call of a noise complaint at 56 Hancock Street. Upon arrival, I spoke to a Mr. Chernov and Ms. Baira who expressed their frustration. They explained that their neighbor was playing her music loudly all day. It should be noted that upon arrival I did not hear the loud music that they stated was being played. Mr. Chernov had me enter his residence so I could better hear the music. Upon entering his residence I could not immediately hear the music. Mr. Chernov and Ms. Baira led me to the corner of their kitchen where I could faintly hear the music. Mr. Chernov advised me that they had a court date on Wednesday the 23rd to resolve these on going neighborly issues.

I then responded to the neighbors adjoining residence and spoke to Ms. West who expressed her frustration with the Police always being called on her. She explained that she felt that her neighbor was being shown favoritism every time they contacted 911. I explained to her that that wasn't true and that we are merely responding to a call for service as if it were reported by anyone. I suggested that Ms. West turn the music down to not cause any more issue with the neighbor for the day. After our conversation she expressed that she knew I was just doing my job and had nothing against her. Due to the music not being played as obnoxiously as was stated and their court date being near the date of the incident no citations were issued at this time.
