Narrative:
On the listed date and time I responded to an heroin overdose at [REDACTED]. Upon arrival [REDACTED] was laying on the dining room floor supine with shallow breathing. [REDACTED] friend stated he took five bags of heroin unknown markings or stamps. [REDACTED] was given one dose of narkan (appropriate forms were faxed) which he became alert and oriented within five minutes. Victim taken to Monmouth Medical Southern Campus for evaluation. There was no heroin at the scene to be seized nor paraphernalia due to [REDACTED] "sniffing" the drug.
[REDACTED] stated his friend gives him heroin bags for free but would not elaborate further. No further action taken.
