

employee when he created a white elephant. The MAYOR told Mr. Sica that no one Councilman is responsible for the Police Facility, that it was the whole Council.

MR. SICA told the Mayor that he was glad he said the appointment of Sherman Umansky, Jr. was not in conflict of interest, because if anything would be in conflict it would be his daughter, even though he has nothing against her and heard she was doing a good job. He said that he called her and found her most courteous. The MAYOR pointed out that Judge Furman ruled that the Mayor could appoint his own Aide and did not specify who he could appoint.

MR. SICA reported that Mr. Sudia and he attended the BLAST Organization meeting at St. Thomas, in Staten Island, in reference to ING. He said that Senator Gregorio, Mayor Cassidy, Sheriff DeMarino, Representative from Mayor Otlowski's Office and the Staten Island Council President were also present. He reported that he and Mr. Sudia spoke on behalf of the Borough of Carteret, were well received, a film was shown and the next meeting would be in Elizabeth.

PHIL SAVITTIERI commended Councilman Wilson on his action in reference to dogs. He stated that the park in West Carteret by Pinho Avenue had the same problem.

LOUIS MANGIERI noted that many change orders were being made on the Police Facility and asked if both the Police and Fire Facilities would be barrier free and the MAYOR replied that this is mandated by State Law. MR. MANGIERI stated that the Rest Rooms at the Dunkin Donut building is still not barrier free and there was no ramp for the handicapped. He stated again that Frank Cap is in conflict of interest when he does work for the Borough because he is also an employee. He asked the Mayor to turn the matter over to the new Borough Attorney.

ANTHONY SEMENZA thanked the Mayor and Council for the second car and welcomed the optimism of allowing them to try it for three (3) months. The MAYOR said he was the first one to object because of the cost factor and sees no reason why the volunteers can't run it. MR. SEMENZA replied that he will be more than pleased with the performance and thanked the Mayor and Council for listening to their input.

JOHN ABATEMARCO stated that he saw Daisy, Mrs. Umansky, at a meeting and she said she just came back from New Brunswick with the Court Order for the Borough Attorney, but that the Order said nothing about the vacancy. BOROUGH ATTORNEY SELESKY replied that the Court Order called for a Special Election. MR. ABATEMARCO asked who is allowed to run and MR. SELESKY replied that it doesn't say. MR. ABATEMARCO asked if both Democrats and Republicans will run and

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BOROUGH ATTORNEY SELESKY replied that Judge Demos ruled that both parities run. MR. ABATEMARCO stated that Judge Demos' opinion was not accepted as yet. MR. SELESKY replied that he is an Assignment Judge and he ordered an Election.

MR. ABATEMARCO stated that no one knows how much money was spent on the Police Facility and he is again questioning the contract and if Ben Den received an extension of time and if not, why he was not penalized. He said it was time the Borough got some money back. He asked the Mayor and Council to have the new Borough Attorney investigate the matter and asked that it be resolved by the next Council Meeting.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business from the Council or the public present, the meeting was adjourned, upon MMS&C by Councilmen Wilson and Umansky.
