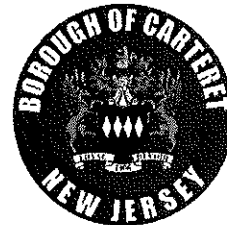

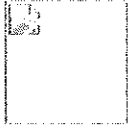

INCIDENT NARRATIVE

On the date and time . Dispatch put the tones out for a working house fire at the address above . Car 3 pulled up and took command did a 360 found smoke coming out the c side of the house on the 2 floor window and was coming out of the first floor kitten area . Command told Ladder 1 arrived to take the front of house is open for him . engine 6 was told to stand by a by the hydrant. When crews went inside to try to find the fire. Ladder 1 alpha and 6 bravo went to try to locate the fire. Off duty personnel started arriving after command requested the tones for a working structure fire. Off duty personnel manned ladder-1. He was ordered to put the aerial ladder to the second floor for means of egress for crew inside. Crews could still not locate the fire. They had smoke coming out of the house next door that was connected to them. Command requested a second alarm assignment. ladder-1 hit the hydrant to get a water supply. Crew inside requested a inch and three quarter line to the front door. Mutual aid companies that arrived Woodbridge truck-1,Avenel 51 Engine, and Perth Amboy Engine-1.Truck -1 arrived and was told by command to go to the access road behind 31 Chrome Ave. When truck-1 arrived behind Chrome Ave they put their aerial up on the Charlie side of the building to the second floor of the building for egress for the crews inside. Avenel arrived they were told by command to bring their man power up to the scene and they were assigned to be the Rit team. Interior attack reported back to command that they had located the fire on the second floor bedroom alpha side. They requested the inch and three quarters at the front to be charged so they could extinguish the fire. They said they put water on the fire and all visible fire was knocked down and they said there would be a extensive overhaul operations. Perth Amboy engine-1 arrived on scene was told by command to bring their man power up to the command post and relieve second floor interior crew for overhaul. 3 bravo 11 was requested to come to the scene to set up rehab for the crews. Car-1 was responding to the scene he came to the command post. Chief requested a incident debriefing. Car-1 assumed command after incident debriefing. Command requested PSE&G and Elizabethtown to secure utilities. Red cross and OEM helped homeowners get relocated.
