

disapproval and his reasons therefor, and shall return the application to the Supervisor. Any determination by the Chief of Police that an application is unsatisfactory shall be based on one (1) or more of the following findings with respect to the applicant:

- (a) Conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude.
- (b) Prior violation of an ordinance or law pertaining to solicitors and canvassers.
- (c) Previous fraudulent acts or conduct.
- (d) Record of breaches of solicited contracts.
- (e) Concrete evidence of bad character.

(2) In the absence of any such finding, the Chief of Police shall find the application satisfactory, shall endorse his approval on the application and shall return the application to the Supervisor.

B. If an application is found unsatisfactory by the Chief of Police and he has endorsed his disapproval upon the application, the Supervisor shall notify the applicant by mail that the application is disapproved, and shall deny the applicant a license. If an application is found satisfactory by the Chief of Police, the Supervisor shall issue a license.

#### Section 8. Revocation of License.

A. Licenses issued under provisions of this chapter may be revoked by the Director after notice and hearing for any of the following causes:

- (1) Fraud, misrepresentation or any false statement contained in the application for license.
- (2) Fraud, misrepresentation or false statement made in the course of carrying on his business as peddler, huckster, vendor, solicitor, itinerant vendor or commercial traveler.
- (3) Any violation of this chapter.
- (4) Conviction of any crime or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
- (5) Conducting the business of peddling in an unlawful manner or in such a manner as to constitute a breach of the peace or to constitute a menace to the health, safety or general welfare of the public.

B. The Supervisor, upon receiving information providing reasonable cause to believe that the holder of any license issued hereunder has violated any provision of this chapter or has been convicted of any violation referred to in this section or has been indicted or charged with or for any crime or offense, or has been convicted of any crime or offense, may forthwith temporarily suspend such license until a hearing is held by the Director of Public Safety as provided herein, and the Director shall have issued a determination thereon.

C. Notice of a hearing for revocation of a license shall be given in writing, setting forth specifically the grounds of the complaint and the time and place of the hearing. Such notice shall be mailed, certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, to the licensee at his last known address at least five (5) days prior to the date set for the hearing.

D. If the licensee has one (1) or more employees, the revocation hereunder shall apply to the licensee and all employees determined to be in violation of this chapter.

E. Upon revocation, the license shall be surrendered to the

Director of Public Safety or his/her designee.

**Section 9. Appeals.** Any person aggrieved by the action of the Chief of Police in the denial of a certificate, as provided in this chapter, shall have the right of appeal to the Director of Public Safety. Such appeal shall be taken by filing with the Chief of Police, within fourteen (14) days after the notice of the action complained of has been mailed to such person's last known address, a written statement setting forth fully the grounds for the appeal. The Director shall set a time and place for hearing on such appeal, and notice of such hearing shall be given to the applicant in the same manner as provided in this chapter for notice of hearing and revocation. The decision of the Director of Public Safety on such appeal shall be final and conclusive.

**Section 10. General Regulations.** No person or license holder shall:

A. Peddle, solicit or distribute merchandise except between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. or sunset, whichever occurs earlier, unless specifically having been invited to a dwelling by an occupant thereof or having previously made an appointment with an occupant.

B. Attempt to peddle, solicit or distribute merchandise or printed material without first having identified himself as a peddler, solicitor or distributor registered with the Borough and displaying his certificate.

C. Have exclusive right to any location in the public streets or operate in any congested area in such a manner as to impede the flow of traffic or of pedestrians or create a breach of the peace.

D. Stand, hawk, peddle or solicit on the premises of any business establishment, shopping center or mall without the written consent of the owner or individual agency or organization responsible for the management and/or operation of the same.

E. Enter or attempt to enter the land of any resident in the Borough where such resident has posted a notice prohibiting such entry.

F. Refuse to leave any private dwelling or property after having been once requested to do so by the owner or occupant thereof.

G. Shout, cry out, blow a horn, ring a bell or use any soundmaking or amplifying device upon any of the streets, parks or public places of the Borough or upon private premises where sound of sufficient volume is emitted or produced therefrom to be capable of being plainly heard upon private premises, for the purpose of attracting attention to any merchandise or services, without first obtaining written authorization for the same from the appropriate Borough official.

H. Litter the streets, public places or public or private properties within the Borough with any merchandise or printed material.

**Section 11. Possession of License; Display.** Every person holding a license under this chapter shall be required to carry the license with him or at his business premises while engaged in the business licensed. He must produce the license upon the request of any interested person.

**Section 12. License Fees.** Nonrefundable license fees shall be ten dollars (\$10.00). No application shall be processed unless accompanied by the license fee along with a fee to defray the police investigation fee of twenty-six dollars (\$26.00), unless this fee has been waived pursuant to Section 3.C, and a refundable deposit of two dollars (\$2.00) for the identification badge as provided in Section 3.

**Section 13. Time Limit.** No license may grant the right to solicit for a period longer than ninety (90) consecutive days.

**Section 14. Religious, Charitable or Political Solicitors and Canvassers.**

A. Any person, firm or corporation soliciting or canvassing on behalf of a bona fide religious, charitable or political organization, as defined in this Ordinance, shall, prior to such solicitation or canvassing, file with the Carteret Borough Police Department a completed application

in the form provided.

B. The application shall contain the following information:

(1) The name and address of the firm, corporation or organization represented by the individual solicitor, when applicable.

(2) The name, address and telephone number of the person in charge of such organization to be contacted in case of emergency.

(3) The name, address (both temporary and permanent), telephone number, social security number and date of birth of all individual solicitors who will be soliciting or canvassing within the Borough of Carteret.

(4) Whether the applicant has been convicted of a crime, disorderly person's offense or violation of any ordinance relating to canvassing or soliciting and, if so, when, where and the nature of the offense; the names of other municipalities in New Jersey where the applicant has been issued a permit to solicit in the past two (2) years.

(5) Whether any motor vehicle will be used in connection with the canvassing or soliciting and, if so, the make, year, color, type and license plate number.

(6) Nature of any goods or services to be sold or the purpose of the solicitations or canvassing.

C. Such application shall be filed with the Carteret Borough Police Department, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the time when such soliciting or canvassing shall take place. In computing the forty-eight-hour period, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays shall be excluded from such computation.

D. Upon completion of the requirements set forth in Subsections A, B and C above, the Carteret Borough Police Department shall issue a permit to the applicant.

E. Each solicitor or canvasser shall be issued a permit by the Borough of Carteret. The permit shall be available to be picked up from the Police Department of the Borough of Carteret. Each permittee shall prominently display the permit upon his person whenever such permittee is engaged in canvassing or soliciting. No permit shall be transferable.

F. Failure to fully comply with the requisites established for issuance of a permit, falsification of any information required to be provided, failure to properly display the permit issued or soliciting or canvassing during prohibited hours shall result in denial or immediate revocation of the applicant's permit.

#### Section 15. Violations and Penalties.

A. Any peddler, transient merchant or itinerant vendor, transient merchant-peddler, merchant peddler or solicitor who shall offer for sale or sell any goods, wares, merchandise, other commodities or bankrupt stock without first paying to the Borough of Carteret the license fee or fees as herein required, or who shall fail to secure a license provided for herein, or who shall make false or fraudulent representations therein, or who shall fail or refuse or neglect to comply with the requirements of this chapter in any part, shall, upon conviction thereof by the Judge of the Municipal Court, pay a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or be imprisoned in the County Jail for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both, and each violation of any of the provisions of this chapter and each day the same is violated shall be deemed and taken to be a separate and distinct offense.

B. The penalties herein provided for shall be in addition to the right of revocation or suspension provided for in Section 7 above.

Section 16. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence,

clause or phrase of this chapter be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portion of this chapter shall not be affected, and to this end, the provisions of this chapter are hereby declared to be severable.

**Section 17. Conflict with Other Laws.** In any case where the provisions of this Code impose a higher standard than set forth in any other ordinance of the Borough of Carteret or under the Laws of the State of New Jersey, then the standards as set forth herein shall prevail, but if the provisions of this Code impose a lower standard than any other ordinance of the Borough of Carteret or of the Laws of the State of New Jersey, then the higher standard contained in any such other ordinance or laws shall prevail.

**Section 18. Effect on Other Provisions.** No license or permit or other certification or compliance with this Code shall constitute a defense against any violation of any other local ordinance applicable to any structure or premises or use of such structure or premises, nor shall any provision herein relieve any owner, operator, tenant or occupant from complying with any such other provision or any official of the Borough of Carteret from enforcing any such other provision.

## ARTICLE II

### Charitable Solicitations

**Section 19. Definitions.** Whenever used in this Article, unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**CHARITABLE NONPROFIT and PHILANTHROPIC** -- Includes political, patriotic, religious, service, welfare, benevolent, educational, civic or fraternal corporations, organizations, associations, societies and the like, not organized for private gain. Examples of "nonprofit organizations" include veterans groups and organizations which assist the poor, the aged, the sick, the physically handicapped or mentally retarded, or which aid victims of fire, flood or similar catastrophies. This enumeration is intended to be typical and shall not be construed as exclusive. All applicants shall provide satisfactory proof of nonprofit status upon request, including but not limited to evidence of tax exemption.

**CONTRIBUTION** -- Includes alms, food, clothes, money, subscription or property of any nature or kind.

**PERSON or ORGANIZATION** -- Any natural person, individual, firm, copartnership, corporation, company, association, church religious denomination, society, class or league and principal or agent thereof.

**SOLICIT and SOLICITATION** -- The request, directly or indirectly, of money, credit, property, financial assistance and other things of value on the plea or representation that such money, credit, property, financial assistance or other thing of value will be used for a charitable and philanthropic purpose as defined in this Article. "Solicitation" shall be deemed to be complete when made, whether or not the person making the same receives any contribution.

**Section 20. Canvassing or Soliciting in Connection with Political Campaign or Charitable or Religious Organization.**

A. Any person canvassing or soliciting in connection with a political campaign or charitable or religious organization or society or any representative of such organization or society, recognized as tax exempt under the United States Internal Revenue Code, when such canvassing or solicitation does not involve the sale or attempted sale of merchandise, shall, at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to such canvassing or solicitation, present himself to the office of the Chief of Police and shall provide said Chief of Police with the following information:

(1) The nature and anticipated duration of such canvassing or solicitation.

(2) The approximate number of persons who will be canvassing or soliciting.

(3) The name and address of the person in charge of such canvassing or solicitation.

(4) The full name and address of the political, charitable or religious organization on behalf of which such solicitation or canvassing is to be conducted.

(5) The names, to the extent known, of the persons who are expected to go from door to door or to distribute materials within the Borough.

B. The purpose of such registration is that the identity of persons going door to door or distributing materials within the Borough may be established for the protection and maintenance of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Borough and to prevent dishonest solicitation of funds in the Borough. No permit or fees shall be required.

C. Such canvassing or soliciting activities shall not be allowed after 9:00 p.m. local time.

**Section 21. Violations and Penalties.** Any person violating the terms of this chapter, whether as principal, agent or employee of another, shall, upon conviction in the Municipal Court, be subject to a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or to imprisonment in the County Jail not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both, in the discretion of the Judge.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 78-24  
ENTITLED, "DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE", ARTICLE IV,  
SECTION 3, PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE  
NUMBER 85-47

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Carteret, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance Number 78-24, entitled "Development Ordinance", Article IV, Section 3, as amended by Ordinance Number 85-47, shall be amended as follows:

Section 3. Certificate of Occupancy required; prerequisites; fees; violations.

(a) No building or structure shall be occupied or used in whole or in part unless and until a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the building inspector. The building inspector shall not issue such certificate unless he determines, after inspection, that there are no violations of any applicable laws, ordinances, or orders pending at the time of issuing the certificate. The certificate shall be issued upon written request from the owner or his authorized agent.

(b) A certificate of occupancy shall be applied for and obtained prior to the use or occupancy of the whole or any part of any building (1) undergoing construction or alteration; (2) undergoing a change in use; (3) undergoing a change in occupancy, except that this provision shall not apply to a change in the occupancy of less than the whole number of dwelling units contained within a building containing more than one dwelling unit when the change of occupancy of such dwelling unit or units occurs within 90 days of the issuance of a prior certificate of occupancy for such unit or units. Upon receiving an application for a certificate of occupancy, the building inspector shall make an inspection of the building or part thereof for which the certificate is requested, and shall forthwith issue the certificate of occupancy if the building or alteration has been completed and if the use and occupancy thereof shall be in conformity with the Revised Ordinances of Carteret or other applicable ordinances of the Borough and if the building or alteration is safe and does not constitute a nuisance or hazard likely to result in injuries to persons or damages to property. In case the building inspector shall decline to issue certificate of occupancy, his reasons for doing so shall be stated to the applicant and a written statement thereof shall be transmitted to the applicant on request.

(c) A certificate of occupancy shall be issued to any person having a proprietary or tenancy interest who shall be held responsible for any violations on the premises. A record of all certificates shall be kept on file by the building inspector and copies shall be furnished to any person having a proprietary or tenancy interest in the building affected.

(d) A fee of \$50.00 shall be paid to the Building Inspection Office for R-3 Use Groups (1 & 2 family dwellings). All Dwelling and Commercial Building a fee of \$100.00.

(e) A monthly report of the certificates of occupancy issued shall be filed with the tax assessor. A record of all certificates of occupancy issued shall be kept in the office of the building inspector.

(f) Any owner occupant of a building, structure or premises, or any architect, builder, contractor, realtor, agent or other person employed in connection therewith, who violates this section or assists in the commission of such violation, shall be subject to the penalty set forth in section 3.

SECTION 2: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication according to law.

# Ordinance of the Borough of Carteret, N. J.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH ENGINEER TO  
PERFORM A SEWER SYSTEM INFLOW STUDY OF THE SEWER  
SYSTEM OF THE BOROUGH OF CARTERET, MIDDLESEX COUNTY,  
NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Carteret:

**SECTION 1:** The Borough has determined, through its Borough Engineer, having conducted a preliminary study, that it is necessary to isolate the source of inflow within the sewer system existing within the Borough of Carteret. Inflow is the direct entry of storm water into a storm system through roof drains, yard drains, manhole covers, direct piping connections, or other such sources. This type of extraneous flow is characterized by sharp increases in flow volume during rainy weather, and relatively sharp decline of flow once the rainy period has ceased. A pattern of such flow within the Borough has existed in the past during periods of wet weather, which has caused sewer backups, and flooding of residential basements of residents of the Borough of Carteret.

**SECTION 2:** It has been determined by the governing body that an update sewer map is necessary for purposes of confronting the sewer backup and flooding problem within the Borough. An accurate and complete update sewer map, therefore, shall be prepared by the Borough Engineer as the first phase of this study project. This map shall include, but not be limited to, the showing of the general location of sewer lines and manholes within the Borough, and shall provide a generalized sewer schematic map, showing the direction of flow within the sewer system.

**SECTION 3:** Phases 2 and 3 of this study shall consist of smoke testing, and a report preparation. The smoke testing shall be utilized as a means of locating inflow sources within the sewer system. The Borough Engineer shall conduct not only the smoke testing, but shall take photographs, and document all potential inflow sources uncovered in the smoke test, and provide said information to the Borough. This information shall be provided by way of a comprehensive report, wherein recommendations shall be made to the Borough with respect to reduction of inflow into the sewer system, and corrective measures which can be determined through the course of the engineering study.

**SECTION 4:** The Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to undertake the aforesaid inflow sewer study, so as to have an anticipated completion date within three months from the commencement of the field work involved in the study. The expense of this study shall not exceed \$70,000.00, and shall be paid for in accordance with appropriate statutes and funding which are available to the Borough of Carteret, by either its general revenue or other funding sources to which the Borough of Carteret may be entitled.

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication provided by Law.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Carteret:

SECTION 1: The Borough of Carteret is under the direction of a Consent Order entered into with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection regarding the closure and post-closure requirements imposed upon the Borough of Carteret of its sanitary landfill, entered into in 1988. Said duties and requirements imposed upon the Borough by the terms of the Consent Order are set forth in a letter dated November 10, 1988 by the Borough Engineer, T&M Associates.

SECTION 2: In accordance with the requirements imposed upon the Borough of Carteret, the Borough Engineer has set forth a guideline and closure plan as indicated in the November 10, 1988 letter.

SECTION 3: Funding of the sanitary landfill closure and post-closure has been previously addressed by the Borough Engineer, and consists of the following: \$178,700.00 - closure of landfill and post-closure requirements; \$23,000.00 additional survey costs and charges; totaling \$201,700.00. Additionally, there are contingency costs and expenses anticipated by the Borough Engineer relative to completion of all necessary closure work and post-closure requirements imposed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, of \$23,300.00, thereby raising the cost of the total sanitary landfill closure project to \$225,000.00. It is hereby determined by the governing body of the Borough of Carteret that this cost and expense is necessary, and must be incurred in order to comply with the requirements of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, as embodied in the Consent Order entered into herein. Said funds shall be satisfied by general revenue derived by the Borough, special funding, and other sources to which the Borough may be entitled for purposes of satisfying this obligation, and the expenditure of this money is hereby approved.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication provided by Law.

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CODE OF ETHICS FOR OFFICIALS OF THE BOROUGH OF CARTERET

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Carteret:

**SECTION 1:** Policy - the public judges its government by the way public officials conduct themselves in the posts to which they are elected or appointed.

The people have a right to expect that every public official will conduct themselves in a manner that will tend to preserve public confidence in and respect for the government they represent.

Such confidence and respect can best be promoted if every public official, whether paid or unpaid, and whether elected or appointed, will uniformly: (a) treat all citizens with impartiality, fairness and equality under the law; and (b) avoid both actual and potential conflicts between their private self-interest and the public self-interest.

**SECTION 2:** Definitions - The terms used in this ordinance are hereby defined as follows:

(a) Financial Interest - Any interest which shall yield, directly or indirectly, a monetary or other material benefit (other than the duly authorized salary or compensation for their services to the Borough) to the official or to any person employing or retaining the services of the official.

(b) Immediate Family - shall include: mother, father, sister, brother, spouse, child, of a public official.

(c) Personal Interest - Any interest arising from blood or marriage relationships or from close business or political association, whether or not any financial interest is involved.

(d) Public Body - Any agency, board, body, commission, committee, department or office of the Borough.

(e) Public Official - Any person elected or appointed to any public office, or public body of the Borough, whether paid or unpaid.

**SECTION 3:** Fair and Equal Treatment - No official shall grant or make available to any person or business any consideration, treatment, advantage, or favor beyond that which is the general practice to grant or make available to the public at large.

### **SECTION 4:** Conflict of Interest:

A. Financial or Personal Interest - No official, either on his own behalf or any other person shall have any financial or personal interest in any business or transaction with any public body unless he first make full disclosure of the nature and extent of such interest.

B. Disclosure and Disqualification - Whenever the performance of his official shall require any official to deliberate and vote on any matter involving his financial or personal interest, he shall publicly disclose the nature and extent of such interest, and disqualify himself from participating in the deliberation as well as in the voting.

C. Incompatible Employment - No official shall engage in private employment with, or render services for, any private person who has business transactions with any public body unless he shall first make full public disclosure of the nature and extent of such employment or services.

D. Representation of Private Person - No official shall appear on behalf of any private person, other than himself, before any public body in the Borough.

E. Gifts and Favors - No official shall accept any gift, whether in the form of money, thing, favor, loan or promise, that would not be offered or given to him if he were not an official.

F. Nepotism - No elected official shall appoint or vote for appointment of any member of their immediate family to any clerkship, office, position, employment or duty, when the salary, wages, pay or compensation is paid out of public funds.

**SECTION 5:** Board of Ethics - There is hereby created and established a board of ethics consisting of three people who shall hold no other office or employment under the Borough. At least one of said members shall be an attorney at law of the State of New Jersey, and said member shall not be required to be a resident of the Borough. All other members shall be residents.

The three members, one of which must be an attorney, so designated above, shall be appointed by a majority of the council. One member shall be appointed by the Mayor. They shall serve for a period of three years, provided, however, that those first appointed hereunder shall have terms expiring one, two, and three years respectively from the date of their commencement of their terms (the Mayor's appointment of those first appointed shall be for two years). Vacancies shall be filled for unexpired terms.

The board shall elect a chairman and a secretary annually. The board shall adopt rules for the conduct of its business.

**SECTION 6:** Advisory Opinions - Upon written request of the official concerned, the board shall render written advisory opinions based upon the provisions of this ordinance. The board shall file its advisory opinions with the Borough Clerk, who shall communicate said opinion to the Borough Council.

**SECTION 7:** Hearings and Determinations - Upon sworn complaint of any person alleging facts which, if true, would constitute improper conduct under the provisions of this ordinance, the board shall conduct a public hearing in accordance with all of the requirements of the due process of law, and, in written findings of facts and conclusions based thereon, make a determination concerning the propriety of the conduct of the official. Said determination shall be reviewable to the Borough Council.

**SECTION 8:** Penalties - Upon a finding of impropriety by the board, the board shall recommend to the Borough Council that a penalty be imposed. They shall include and be limited to: (A) a formal reprimand; (B) removal from their Official position.

A formal reprimand requires a majority vote by the Borough Council.

A public Official can only be removed from office upon a unanimous vote of the board, and the formal acceptance by the council of the recommendation by a two-thirds vote of the council. Said resolution of removal shall be placed upon the public ballot at the next primary or general election. Said removal must be approved by a majority of the voters voting on the issue.

**SECTION 9:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication provided by Law.

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE 78-24, ARTICLE III, DEFINITIONS, #47 FENCES"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Carteret, Development Ordinance 78-24, Article III, Definitions, #47 Fences, shall be amended as follows:

A. Purpose. The intention of these requirements is to provide standards for the protection of the health, safety and aesthetic values of adjacent property.

B. Intersections. At the intersection of two (2) or more streets, no wall, fence, hedge or other structure shall be erected to a height in excess of three (3) feet above curb level, nor shall any other obstruction to vision be permitted within the triangular area formed by the intersecting street lines at points which are twenty-five (25) feet distant from the point of intersection, measured along said street line. Trees whose branches are trimmed away to a height of at least ten (10) feet above curb level shall be permitted.

C. Height. On any lot in any residence district, no wall, fence or hedge shall be erected or altered so that said wall or fence shall be over four (4) feet in height in the front yard or over six (6) feet in height in the side or rear yards, except that tennis court fences may have a maximum height of twelve (12) feet. Tennis courts and front yard fences shall be restricted to open mesh or other open material as approved by the Construction official.

D. Dangerous fence material. No fence in any zone shall be erected of barbed wire or electrified or topped with metal spikes or constructed of any material or in any manner which may be dangerous to persons or animals.

E. Type. Solid architectural fences shall be required along all lot lines except the street line for all nonresidential lots where said property lines abut residential zoning district lines. Such architectural fences may be made of any material which is aesthetically pleasing and prevents the dissemination of odors, noise, debris and sight across the residential zoning boundary. Fences used for this purpose shall be not less than six (6) feet in height. Nothing in this section prevents the use of plant materials along any lot line in addition to the fence requirement, but plant materials cannot be substituted for the fence. Open chain link and chain link with plastic or aluminum slats shall not be considered to be an architecturally solid fence. A wall or fence which restricts the natural flow of drainage or causes stagnant water conditions shall not be permitted. Said wall or fence shall be ordered removed or corrected by the owner upon direction of the Construction Official. The municipal agency shall have the authority to waive this requirement if a buffer area is landscaped to its requirements.

F. Maintenance. In any zone, walls or fences erected shall be maintained in an aesthetically pleasing manner, and any failure to do so shall be subject to the Construction Officials' order to repair or replace the wall or fence in order to meet the requirements of this chapter.

G. Swimming Pools. There shall be a fence, not less than four (4) feet high, completely enclosing any below-ground swimming pool and any other swimming pool of one hundred (100) square feet of surface water area or more and which is less than four (4) feet above the ground. Each gate in a pool fence shall be capable of being locked when not in use.

H. Permit required. It shall be unlawful for any person to erect, repair, replace or alter any fence as defined in this ordinance without first obtaining a building permit.

# Ordinance of the Borough of Carteret, N. J.

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PURCHASE OF A STREET SWEEPER FOR THE BOROUGH OF CARTERET, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$85,000.00, THEREFORE FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH FOR THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CARTERET IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this Bond Ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Carteret, New Jersey as a General Improvement. For the improvement or purpose described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$85,000.00 for the improvement or purpose described therein which amount is made available from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough.

Section 2. The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for which the appropriation of Capital Improvement Fund money is made available is to provide for the Purchase of a Street-Sweeper for the Borough, including the acquisition of all Materials necessary thereof or incidental thereto.

Section 3. The Capital Budget of the Borough of Carteret is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 4. The purposes described in Section 2 of this Bond Ordinance are not current expenses. They are all improvements that the Borough may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the costs thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after Final Adoption, as provided by law.
