

CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, between the City of Pleasantville, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, having its principal offices located at 18 North First Street, Pleasantville, NJ 08232, hereinafter referred to as "City" and TriCare Medical Transportation., having its principal place of business located at 825 Noah's Road, Pleasantville, NJ 08232 hereinafter referred to as "Contractor";

WITNESSETH;

That for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$-7,500.00-), per month, contractor agrees to furnish to the City, the labor, materials, equipment and services in accordance with the contract document hereinafter set forth. Payments will be made on or about the 15th of each month for the term of the contract listed below.

That for and in consideration of the amount payable under this agreement by the City, the Contractor agrees, at its own proper cost and expense, and with due skill and diligence, that it will provide the EMS Basic Life Support and Emergency Medical Service Response and Transportation Services, in accordance with the bid/contract documents and in compliance with this agreement.

The Contract documents shall consist of the following:

1. Contractor's Proposal (as accepted)
2. Contract Agreement

The parties to this contract agree to incorporate into this contract the mandatory language of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, as amended and supplemented from time to time and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions, and obligations of said Regulations.

These agreements, together with the contract documents, form the contract and they are as fully a part of this contract as if hereto attached or herein repeated.

The City and Contractor, for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, hereby agree to the full performance of the covenants herein contained.

This contract shall run from November 1, 2020 to October 31, 2023. This contract may be extended for two (2) additional one- year terms by mutual agreement of all parties. In addition, after the first 24 months of the contract, monthly consideration will be review to determine if changes are needed. This review will be done on an annual basis thereafter.

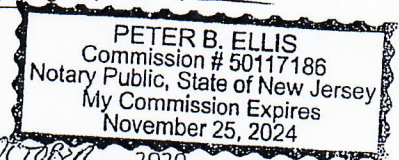

"A RESOLUTION TO RENEW THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
PLEASANTVILLE AND TRICARE MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the current EMS Services Review Contract is set to expire October 31, 2020;
and

WHEAREAS the City wishes to renew the EMS Services contract with Tricare Medical
Transportation at the monthly cost of \$7,500.00; and

WHEREAS the Contract will be for the period of three years as of November 1, 2020 thru
October 31, 2023, with two one (1) year option at the choice of City Council; and
