I'm working on a feasibility study for the unmanned data center facility that I mentioned last week, and I have a quick question regarding tree protection requirements. When ordering a tree survey for the site, what is the minimum size tree we need them to pick up? Section 16.18.080.C mentions 4" caliper trees, but 16.16.040.B.13 says to identify trees 8" or greater. Which size should we request as the minimum to pick up in their survey? Also, do tree surveys need to be completed by a licensed arborist providing a sealed report?
