February 3, 2021: At 3:40pm, I arrived at 1027 Robin Street, Building 31, Green Brook. There was a food dish with wet and dry cat food next to the front door. I spoke with feeder Heather Ryllun, [REDACTED] I informed her of the complaint that the food was drawing in cats and foxes. I asked if she had an outdoor cat she was feeding, and she said a feral orange DSH with one eye had shown up about a month ago. She left food out for it because she felt sorry for it. I asked her to at least bring the food in at night to deter wildlife from coming and asked her to email us a picture of the cat. I told her we would send the information and picture of the cat to the town to see if they would like us to trap. She is willing to trap but has nowhere to take it. She does have an unlicensed indoor cat. I cleared the scene at 3:54pm. Officer Hensley

2/5/21, 9:58am I sent an email to Anthony, Green Brook Licensing Department requesting a letter for unlicensed cats be sent to owner. Manager Dare

2/5/21 at 11:07 AM I assigned Officer Wolfenden to complete the welfare check. ACO to ask pertinent questions to determine if there is an owner. FOM Vastola

February 5th at 11:12am I contacted Heather Ryllun [REDACTED] 1027 Robin Ct, Green Brook. I left a voicemail requesting a call back and asking about the cat's injury, and if it had an ear notch as well as if she was taking responsibility for the cat. Call ended. At 11:31am I received a message from FOM Vastola stating she had contacted me back. I then called her and she stated that she had listened to my voicemail. She stated that the injury seemed old but it was not sewn shut nor did it seem medically done. She stated that she was unable to get close to the cat and is unsure about the ear tip. She also stated that she only started feeding the cat because of the snow and feeling bad for it and she did not want to be considered the caretaker/responsible person for the cat. Call ended. At 11:38am I arrived near the residence. I posted the doors for the apartments on her floor as well as the couple on the lower floor (#1019, 1021, 1023, 1025, 1029) requesting the residents contact us with any information about the cat and/or a possible owner as no one answered their doors. I also went to the joint mailbox area for that part of the complex and posted a near each end of the mailbox area so that other residents nearby would see them and be able to contact us with any information. I cleared the area at 11:58am. At this time I saw no signs of feeding near Ms. Ryllun's apt. Officer Wolfenden

2/6/21: 2/5/21 at 9:34 PM I received an assignment from Officer Murin to follow up with Kimberly Fromm, [REDACTED] 1023 Robin Court, Green Brook, as she responded to a door posting. 2/6/21 at 9:38 AM I called Kimberly. I asked if the cat in question appears to be actively suffering/has open wounds. She stated it looks healthy and well fed. She stated it has had an old wound for as long as she remembers: the right eye is dark, possibly non-working, but she did not see blood or any fluid coming from it. She stated the cat is part of a group of cats that has been around for at least 3 years as that was when she moved in. She stated it comes around a couple times a day and sits in front of neighbor's door (she was driving, and did not remember the neighbor's address). She stated it and 4 or 5 other cats come around as there is food put out in the hallway. She was unsure who is feeding, but stated she does not. She stated she got some pictures. I asked her to send them to my work phone when she can. See attached photo I thanked her and call ended. FOM Vastola

On 2/5/21 at 7:18pm I received a call from Kimberly Fromm, 1023 Robin Court, Green Brook. She asked for Officer Wolfenden and I stated she is not working tonight and asked if there was anything I could do for her. She said she got a post on her door regarding a cat that lives outside in the area. She said the cat is sitting right outside her door now. I asked if the cat was actively injured or suffering, and she said just an old eye wound, but no. I told her I was unfamiliar with the case and that an Officer would follow up tomorrow. Attached is a picture of the cat. The incident occurred on Thursday 9/10/21 at approx 7:00 pm. Our 2 year old grandson awoke from a nap in our living room. He was stirring and began to slide off the side off the couch. My wife and I immediately lunged for him. At that time the cat snapped and went after my grandson. My grandson had scratches on his legs, scalp and left side of his face. My daughter also sustained scratches in the attack.

This was the first time the cat showed any aggressive behavior. He normally has a sweet disposition and is friendly with us as well as strangers to him that come in to the house. He has not exhibited any aggressive behavior since the incident.

The cat was brought to us after my daughter came home from college. She has since moved out and left the cat with us. All I know about the cat is he is a Korat and a little over 4 years old. My daughter got him from a co-worker when he was 2 weeks old. She is unaware if he was vaccinated or not.

The cat is an indoor cat and we will continue to keep him in quarantine. We would like more information before we make a determination on surrendering him. I was advised that you would reach out on 9/19/21 after the quarantine is completed.

Call ended. I arrived at 10:15am, and Dave led me to where the cat was. I saw the cat resting on the ground next to a car, grooming her tail. The cat is a Siamese, likely belonging to someone. I called out to the cat but got no response. I collected my snare pole and cage from my van and carefully approached the cat. As I got closer, the cat noticed I was there, but clearly had a hard time seeing exactly where I was. The cat, being a Siamese, also had crossed eyes. The cat didn't run away so I slowly approached, placing my cage and snare pole on the ground. I snapped my fingers and waved my hand around the cats head and got absolutely no response from the cat. I observed the cat couldn't hear me at all or see me very well. I observed that since the cat was a very dark Siamese, she was probably pretty old, so I checked her teeth to see if any dental work had been done. I observed the cat had no teeth. The cat let me pick her up. I placed her in a cage in my van, as she is blind and deaf, I didn't want her to wander off and get hurt. She's very friendly. I conducted a welfare check on the area, those who answered their doors said that no one in the area owns a cat of that description.
