Bahooshian stated while he was walking his dog along Woodcrest Ln, a German Shepherd with black/dark brown fur approached and began to attack his dog. Bahooshian further stated that in order to protect his dog, he placed himself between the two dogs and grabbed the shepherd by the mouth in an attempt to free his dog from it. Bahooshian stated he was able to fight off the other dog at which point it ran away. Bahooshian appeared to have a dragging bite mark on his right wrist, two puncture marks on his left hand and a scrape on his left knee, all of which appeared to be fresh and actively bleeding. Bahooshian denied treatment on scene and advised he would seek medical attention in the morning. Bahooshian recognized the dog and believed it belonged to the resident at 7 Woodcrest Ln, now known to me as Daniel DiAndrea. Bahooshian was advised of the procedure to sign complaints.

Upon speaking to DiAndrea, he stated his dog, Shiva, had been outside of the residence but in his control. DiAndrea stated he believed the dog may have seen a deer, causing her to run away from him and down the street. DiAndrea stated he did not witness the incident, but noticed Shiva seemed to be behaving more timidly, acting as if something had happened to her, and would not let DiAndrea near her when she returned to the residence. DiAndrea stated that there had been no prior incidents with Shiva.

DiAndrea provided a valid license and rabies vaccination record for his dog. DiAndrea was also served a notice of quarantine for the animal. Notification was made to the health department.

At approximately 9:30 PM on August 7, 2020 while walking Miniature Schnauzer Jax on a leash in a residential neighborhood in front of 34 Woodcrest Lane Michael Bahooshian was attacked by neighbor Daniel DiAndrea's (7 Woodcrest Lane) German Shepherd. DA's German Shepherd lunged and wrapped his jaws around the torso of Jax. MB dove to Jax simultaneously as the shepherd grabbed Jax and was able to inhibit GS from inflicting serious injury to Jax by using his hands to release and open GS jaws. Jax

and MB experienced a similar attack a few houses away on December 13, 2017 from the same owners German Shepard which resulted in serious injury to Jax. That attack resulted in a six month physical recuperation and permanent behavior damage for Jax. This incident was similar however resulted in limited physical harm to Jax but severe injury to MB. The previous attack MB wore gloves and after struggling with the GS to unleash Jax MB suffered injury to his hands resulting in one puncture wound to the left hand and bruised knees from wrestling on the ground with the Shepherd. Jax however was victim to multiple lacerations on his neck, torso, back, and severe blood loss. Requiring emergency medical care.

On this occasion while attempting to remove GS from Jax GS bit MB multiple times. Once Jax was free of GS's jaws Jax remained in the street with his leash on standing motionless in what appeared to be shock. MB screamed for him to go home. MB and GS remained in a struggled while MB screamed for help. Finally MB's daughter Samantha heard the screaming but could not visually see because it was dark. Pit Bull attack of dog owned by Linda Lewis of Green Brook, NJ
 Sept. 9, 2020
 I was walking my 20-pound Havanese dog, Luca, on School Street on a standard 6-foot leash at about 7 pm on Wednesday, September 9. We entered the center of the roadway from the grass at the south end of School Street where the street dead ends. No dogs were visible anywhere in the street or in the adjacent yards.

A woman was in the driveway of 7 School Street, the second property on the left side of the street. She was removing groceries from her car and carrying them into her house through the front door, which was propped open. No dog was visible as we walked forward, passing the driveway in the center of the roadway.

Suddenly, a large brown dog appeared next to my right leg, lunging toward my leashed dog, who had just as suddenly run to the limit of his leash, pulling it out of my hand. The brown dog made no noise and I did not see her coming. The next thing I remember is seeing my dog between the jaws of the brown dog and hearing him scream. I started screaming myself, and attempting to get close enough to my dog to grab him. I never touched the brown dog.

The owner of the brown dog appeared and reached over the back of her animal, reaching forward to grab the brown dog's facial skin. She pulled hard on her dog's face, who after 10 seconds or so released my dog. I then reached over her dog as she dragged the brown dog backward, grabbed my dog in my hands and raised him straight up in the air.

At this point, the owner of the brown dog lost her grip on the animal. Her brown dog immediately jumped up after my dog and grabbed him between his legs from behind. The brown dog's top teeth were on my dog's back, her bottom teeth in his abdomen and his tail and buttocks were in her mouth. She pulled my dog down and out of my hands. The brown dog's owner then grabbed her dog by the face again, eventually forcing her to release my dog. I then picked my dog up again and turned away from the brown dog, getting him away.

I stood with my dog cradled in my arms for about a minute; both of us were very shocked. During this time, an older man appeared whom I did not know and still cannot identify. He wanted to know if I was all right, I believe. I said, "I have to take him to a vet" and started to walk toward my home, about 400 feet away. He stopped me, untangled my dog's leash from my lower legs and draped it over my shoulder. I did not see the brown dog or her owner during this time. I walked away then, and as I left the brown dog's owner appeared next to me and followed me home, saying how sorry she was and how she would pay for his vet care. I took my dog into my house and set him down. He was fully awake but subdued. I took a few minutes to locate an emergency vet using my computer, then took the dog to my car and set him in his crate for the trip to the vet. The owner of the brown dog, who was in the street outside my house, came into my driveway wanting to see if my dog was all right; at some point she also handed me a slip of paper with her first name and her cell phone number on it. I'm afraid I took the paper then completely ignored her and drove away.

I saw the owner of the brown dog once more that evening. The veterinarians at Animerge in Raritan, where my dog was treated, told me that the brown dog's owner needed to provide them with proof of rabies vaccination; not just a statement but to fax them physical proof. I attempted to call Diane using the number she gave me, but the call went to voicemail and her mailbox was full and would not accept a message. Therefore, I stopped at her house and told her to call Animerge to find out what sort of proof they would accept. She agreed to do this, and I left.

December 7th at 9:49am I received a message from Officer Hensley regarding a call from the wife of Greg Becker [REDACTED]. She was calling to give us his information as he was trying to have us do a welfare check at his mother's residence: 45 Blue Ridge Ave, Green Brook. At 9:52am I contacted Mr. Becker. The call went straight to voicemail without ringing. I left a message stating who I was and why I was calling. I requested a call back so we could set up a welfare check. Call ended. Officer Wolfenden

December 7th at 10:25am I received a message from Officer Hensley that Greg Becker [REDACTED] had contacted us back about 45 Blue Ridge Ave, Green Brook. I attempted to contact him again but it went straight to voicemail so I left another voicemail requesting a call back. Call ended. At 10:28am I received another message from Officer Hensley. She gave me a new number to call [REDACTED] contacted Mr. Becker and was able to speak with him. He stated he'd be at the residence all day. We agreed for me to do the welfare check at 11am. I asked if he could send a photo of the cat/kitten he stated he thinks is approx 10-12 weeks old. I saw the photo and was unable to tell. Call ended. At 11:01am I arrived at the residence. I spoke with Mr. Becker. He showed me where the kitten was hanging out. It is black and white, unknown sex, 10-12 weeks old. He stated they have 2 outdoor black cats that they feed, he showed me the feeding station, and the cat houses he had built (see photos). Without prompting he stated that they have set times for feeding the cats unless they are outside and can monitor the feeding station which is why he noticed the little black and white young cat hanging around. He stated they bring the food in at night so that wildlife doesn't get to it. He stated both of their cats are spayed. I asked how long the kitten had been hanging around. He stated today was the first he'd seen it. He stated that normally he'd just get it spayed/neutered himself and try to re home it but he stated he and his mother are getting too old for that. I stated I understood. He asked about feeding it and I advised trying to keep from feeding it if possible as it would deter it from going back to where it may have come from. Mr. Becker stated he'd been keeping it away from the feeding station and it was hiding in a well shed by his driveway (see photo). I then went and did my welfare check. I posted doors at #49, and #48. The resident at #46 opened the door, waved me off and closed and locked the door so I posted her door as well. I then posted #44 as there was no answer. At 42 Blue Ridge Ave the resident answered the door with her dog. One of her 2 orange indoor/outdoor cats ran outside. She stated that both of her cats are spayed/neutered and she was unaware of a younger cat roaming around. I thanked her for the information. I then went to #41 and posted the door as no one answered. I went back to Mr. Becker and advised we would send the report into the town to see what they wanted to do moving forward and we would get back to him. He thanked me for coming out so quickly. Cleared 11:29am. CCing Officer Hensley in case we receive any call backs. There are no dogs or cats licensed to 45 or 42 Blue Ridge Ave. I'm requesting letters be sent to Mr. Becker for 2 unlicensed cats, and to the resident at #42 for 2 unlicensed cats and 1 unlicensed dog. 12/11/20, 11:13am, I assigned Officer Wolfenden to follow up and see if the cat/kittens are still around. ACO to inquire if they are still healthy. Manager Dare
