2. Calls received between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., and on weekends and holidays, will be for emergency only. This pertains to dog bites or dogs hit by car and are still alive.
3. All expenses payable to the animal shelter facility for the care of any animals turned over by Contractor shall be the responsibility of the Township or the animal's owner, and shall not be the responsibility of the Contractor.

1. To receive calls from Township Officials, Police, or Residents to pick up loose or stray animals and to respond to such calls and utilize proper means to capture and restrain such loose or stray animals, and to take such loose or stray animals, once confined, to a proper animal shelter facility as designated by the Township.
2. Calls received between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., and on weekends and holidays, will be for emergency only. This pertains to dog bites or dogs hit by car and are still alive.
3. All expenses payable to the animal shelter facility for the care of any animals turned over by Contractor shall be the responsibility of the Township or the animal's owner, and shall not be the responsibility of the Contractor.

4. The cost of transporting animals to the animal care facility shall be the responsibility of the Contactor.
5. The amount to be paid under this Contract shall be \$475.00 _____ PER MONTH, which shall be payable to Contractor, and shall hold Township harmless for any claims resulting from the operation of said motor vehicle or other activities in performance of the Contract.

CONTRACT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES

This Agreement, made and entered into this 17th day of January, 2019 by and between the Township of Alloway and Edmund H. Shimp, Jr. for animal control services from February 1, 2019 to January 31, 2020.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1 EDMUND H. SHIMP, JR. shall perform the following services in and for Alloway Township from February 1, 2019 to January 31, 2020:

A. Pick up and transport stray animals to shelter with whomever Alloway Township has contracted with to hold animals. However, animals that are picked up with a license tag shall be taken to their home or the owners shall be called to pick up their animal at no charge.

B. Remove and dispose of dead animals that are killed on roadways.

C. Handle rabies calls.

D. Handle complaints regarding animals and appear at court, if necessary, to present evidence on behalf of the municipality concerning alleged violations.

E. Apprehend and transport to the designated shelter any animal found to be running at large or any stray animal when reported.

F. Provide animals with humane treatment in conformity with the rules and regulations of the State Department of Health.

G. Be on twenty-four (24) hour call.

H. Edmund H. Shimp, Jr. shall provide a sufficient staff for the Township's Annual Rabies Clinic held in January 2019, to assist in the issuance of rabies vaccination certificates.

I. Calls received between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. and on weekends and holidays, will be for emergency only.

J. All expenses payable to the animal shelter facility for the care of any animals turned over by Contractor shall be the responsibility of the Township or the animal's owner, and shall not be the responsibility of the Contractor.

K. The cost of transporting animals to the animal care facility shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

L. PATROL: All activity shall be in accordance with state mandates.

2 Alloway Township shall pay Edmund H. Shimp, Jr. for said services listed above \$475.00 per month. Payment shall be made upon presentation of a voucher and monthly report at the first meeting of the Township Committee after the end of the month for which it is billed.

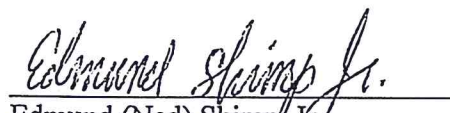
Either party may terminate this agreement with 30 days prior notice to the other party.

This Agreement, made and entered into this 16th day of January, 2020 by and between the Township of Alloway and Edmund H. Shimp, Jr. for animal control services beginning February 1, 2020 to January 31, 2021.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1 EDMUND H. SHIMP, JR. shall perform the following services in and for Alloway Township from February 1, 2020 to January 31, 2021:

- A. Pick up and transport stray animals to shelter with whomever Alloway Township has contracted with to hold animals. However, animals that are picked up with a license tag shall be taken to their home or the owners shall be called to pick up their animal at no charge.

2 PAYMENT:

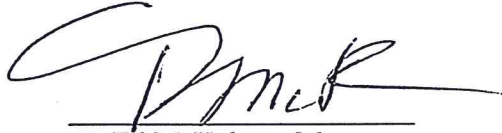

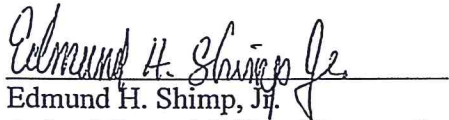
Either party may terminate this agreement with 30 days prior notice to the other party.
