The Division of Local Government Services has reviewed your request for the Lakewood Board of Education to secure a Security Officer Services through competitive contracting.

Considering the level and characteristics of the service and competition in the marketplace, the Division has concluded that the subject matter is consistent with the intent of the statutory provisions pertaining to competitive contracting. On behalf of the Director, I am approving your request pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4.1k to use competitive contracting to procure the above-referenced services.

In developing and implementing a competitive contracting process, the Board shall comply with the statutory (N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4.1 through 4.5) and regulatory (N.J.A.C. 5:34-4.1 et seq.) provisions governing same. While the Division will not review the actual application of the evaluation criteria or the selection of a contractor based on such criteria, the Board is expected to apply the criteria in a non-discriminatory manner. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4.2, the term of the contract shall not exceed five years. Please note that 18A: 18A-42, contract extensions are limited to one two-year or two one-year extensions.
