The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

Ocean County Sheriff's Office Arrest Narrative-

Sergeant Adrian Bullock #95, Detective John Frassetto #172 and I executed an arrest warrant at the [REDACTED]. The warrant execution was in reference to four violation of Probation warrants for Anthony Carta. (18-3204/18-3205/18-3206/18-3207) While approaching the trailer, we could hear a male and female conversing inside the trailer. Through a window we were able to identify Carta by his sleeve tattoo. [REDACTED] front door and knocked. After knocking the talking ended and all the lights in the trailer were turned off. I knocked multiple times and announced myself. After no answer I opened and pushed the door open. A female was on her knees in front of a couch. I ordered her to her feet and out of the trailer. Bullock and I made entry into the living room part of the trailer. Carta was laying on the floor in the corner of the living room. I ordered Carta to his feet and up against the wall. The female, later identified as Shayna Palmieri was found to be wanted for a N/S warrant #18-2601.

Carta and Palmieri were both handcuffed (double locked) and searched incident to arrest for weapons, implements of escape and contraband with negative results. Both Carta and Palmieri were not fingerprinted or photographed in accordance to policy.

I notified the Radio Room and spoke with #679 concerning the above warrants were properly served.

Carta and Palmieri was transported in vehicle #189 to Ocean County Jail by Frassetto and I and turned over to Ocean County Corrections Officer Howorth, where they were lodged without incident.

The rear seat of vehicle #189 was searched pre/post transport for contraband with negative results.

Carta and Palmieri had no additional wants or warrants.
