- A. On September 18th, 2023, the Seaside Heights Police Department was notified and responded to an incident of a reported fall victim in the area of Sumner Avenue and Central Avenue. Upon arrival, officers observed a male, later identified as Robert May, laying on the ground next to his bicycle bleeding from a laceration to his head.
- B. Mr. May was treated on scene and subsequently refused further medical attention. Additionally, May was uncooperative and did not provide information to officers regarding the incident. Mr. May then entered into his residence of [REDACTED] after refusing medical treatment.
- C. While on scene, officers received information that a black male and white female were in the area with this fall victim and that he did not fall, instead he had been assaulted by the black male. The male was described as wearing a purple t-shirt and last seen walking westbound on Central Avenue.
- D. Officers attempted to locate this male with negative results. Officers then attempted to identify this male through means of recovering surveillance video. Surveillance video was located inside of Babe's Corner Store and showed a male matching the description on the video. Officers were then able to identify the suspect as Mr. Anthony P. Collins (DOB [REDACTED] 1983).
- E. Video was also located and later retrieved from the Metropole Motel and [REDACTED] showing Mr. Collins leaving the area of the assault. Video was also able to assist in identifying the female with Mr. Collins as Ms. Alison Nastvogel (DOB [REDACTED] 1984).
- F. At approximately 1704 hours, the Seaside Heights Police Department received another call in regards to Mr. May. This call was from his roommate, identified as Mr. Oscar Reyes. Mr. Reyes stated that Mr. May was speaking incoherently and should probably be taken to the hospital. Mr. May was again seen by Tri-Boro Ems and transported to Community Medical Center.
- G. On September 19th, 2023 the Seaside Heights Police Department received information that Mr. May had been transported to Robert

Wood Johnson. I was notified and responded to the Seaside Heights Police Department to continue the investigation. I was notified that Mr. May was in the shock trauma unit, on a ventilator, sedated and considered to be in stable condition. Mr. May's condition never improved from this initial report on his status.

- H. During the investigation, Ms. Nastvogel came to the Seaside Heights Police Department Municipal Court and asked to speak to an officer about the assault incident. I spoke with Ms. Nastvogel and asked if she was willing to provide a taped statement. She agreed and provided a voluntary taped statement in regards to the incident.
- I. Ms. Nastvogel provided a statement explaining that Mr. May, a coworker of hers, and Mr. Collins, whom she described as her boyfriend, do not get along because Mr. May calls her phone and bothers her with nonsense from time to time. These phone calls have over time upset Mr. Collins.
- J. Ms. Nastvogel stated that on September 18th, 2023, she and Anthony were in the area of Sumner and Central Avenue and had just left Babes Corner Store. Mr. May hit Alison in the hip with his bike and engaged in a verbal altercation with Mr. Collins and called him a "nigger". Mr. Collins then punched Mr. May, who was still on his bike, in the right side of his jaw with a closed fist causing him to fall off of his bike and hit his head on the pavement. Ms. Nastvogel stated that she walked off eastbound after this incident and Mr. Collins walked westbound, heading back to their apartment located at [REDACTED].
- K. Ms. Nastvogel then stated that her son informed her that Mr. Collins arrived home, turned his shirt inside out and then left Seaside Heights. She stated that they had spent the night at the Pelican Inn & Suites in Toms River before she returned to Seaside Heights on September 19th, 2023. This interview was then concluded.
- L. Based on Mr. May's condition not improving, I contacted Ms. Nastvogel in an attempt to obtain contact information for Mr. Collins. Ms. Nastvogel stated that Mr. Collins doesn't have a cellular telephone and that they have been sharing the same phone

for months. She identified the phone as having the number [REDACTED] and was the same phone number I was currently calling her on. She also stated that she did not know the whereabouts of Mr. Collins and that he only calls her from blocked phone numbers. A lookup of this phone number came back with the carrier serviced by Verizon.

M. On Sunday, October 1, 2023, at approximately 0200 hours, May was pronounced dead by Dr. Labinek of Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital. On the same date, at approximately 1440 hours, a postmortem examination was conducted on the body of the decedent. The examination, which took place at Community Medical Center, was conducted by Dr. Ragasa of the Ocean County Medical Examiner's Office. Dr. Ragasa determined the cause of death to be Blunt Force Injury resulting from Mr. May being assaulted and caused to fall off of his bicycle and the manner of death to be Homicide.

N. On October 2nd, 2023 myself, Det. Mitchell of the Ocean County Prosecutors Office and patrol officers from the Seaside Heights Police Department responded to [REDACTED] in an attempt to make contact with Mr. Anthony Collins. I knocked on the door to the apartment and later spoke with Ms. Alison Nastvogel who stated that Mr. Collins was not in the residence and asked if we wished to confirm that he was not there by searching the apartment. Mr. Collins was confirmed to not be in the apartment after a search. We asked Ms. Nastvogel the location of Mr. Collins and she stated she did not know where he was. We asked if she was in contact with Mr. Collins and she last had contact with Mr. Collins two days prior. We advised her that we would be seizing her cell phone as it may contain evidence of the crime of manslaughter and may lead us to Mr. Collins's location. Ms. Nastvogel stated that she would not consent to a search of her phone and that we needed to apply for a search warrant to get into her phone. Ms. Nastvogel's phone was then seized and I took possession of the phone. While in possession of the phone Ms. Nastvogel received a call from a contact stored in her phone as "B", when asked who was calling her, she hesitated and then stated

that it was Mr. Collins. This phone was then taken to the Seaside Heights Police Department.

- O. Additionally, detectives spoke with Steve Lawson. Lawson indicated that on the day of the assault he was at La Fontana Motel. He was walking to the bus stop when he saw the decedent in the roadway. He subsequently went to check on the decedent, whom Lawson stated was unconscious. Lawson further stated that while on scene he spoke with three (3) unidentified Hispanic males. The males told him that the decedent was hit by a black male wearing a purple shirt and that he has left the area. It should be noted that the clothing described by Lawson is consistent with the clothing seen being worn by Collins in surveillance.
- P. At the Seaside Heights Police Department, I reviewed the body cam footage of our attempt to make contact with Mr. Collins. While I was in possession of the phone it rang and I observed the number to be [REDACTED], during this attempt to make contact with Mr. Collins I asked Ms. Nastvogel who was calling and I said the number out loud. A later check of this number identified the carrier as Verizon Wireless.
- Q. On October 3rd 2023, I was able to locate witnesses who were in the area during the time of the assault. I was able to locate a male who was later identified as Mr. Eleno Levy-Ortiz. As a result, Sgt. Melissa Matthews, of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office responded to the Seaside Heights Police Department to conduct the taped statements in Spanish. Mr. Levy-Ortiz stated he was leaving Babe's Corner Store and while he was walking away from Babe's he heard what he described as a noise, when he turned around, he observed Mr. Robert May laying on the ground and Mr. Collins walking away from Mr. May.
- R. We were also able to locate a witness identified as Mr. Lucas Jamie Chino-Hernandez. Mr. Chino-Hernandez stated that he was leaving Babe's with Mr. Levy-Ortiz. He also heard the noise, turned around and saw Mr. May laying on the ground next to his bicycle and Mr. Collins standing at his feet before Mr. Collins began to walk away.

- S. Also located on October 3rd, 2023 was Mr. Mehulkuma Patel. Mr. Patel stated that he was walking westbound on the opposite side of the street and observed in his peripheral Mr. Collins to, what he believed to be, strike Mr. May causing him to fall off of his bicycle and fall to the ground. He later stated that after the incident Mr. Collins began to walk away westbound away from the area of Babe's. Additionally, Mr. Patel stated that based on the positioning of Mr. Collins and Ms. Nastvogel, it could only have been Mr. Collins that caused the injury. While speaking with Mr. Patel a male, later identified as Mr. Shawn Myres, approached and began to tell me about the incident under investigation. He stated that he spoke with Ms. Nastvogel a day after the incident and he stated that she related to him that she "rocked" Mr. May indicating that she was the one who assaulted him.
- T. On October 4th, I was able to make contact with Ms. Nastvogel at her residence. Ms. Nastvogel voluntarily gave a statement in regards to the assault. Ms. Nastvogel clarified again that Mr. Collins struck Mr. May with his fist in the left side of his face causing him to fall off of his bicycle and strike his head on the ground. Ms. Nastvogel and Mr. Collins both left the area separately. Ms. Nastvogel also was asked to clarify what Mr. Myres said to us. Ms. Nastvogel stated that she did not hear what was said between Mr. May and Mr. Collins. She stated that she did not strike Mr. May and was only trying to take the blame for the incident prior to being made aware of the severity of the injury.
- U. On October 4th, Det. Mitchell and I met with Deputy First Assistant Prosecutor Robert Armstrong and Chief Trial Attorney Michael Weatherstone and Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman. The above listed assistant prosecutors were presented with the facts and approved the charges of manslaughter in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:11-4b and endangering an injured victim in violation of N.J.S.A 12-1.2a.
