MINUTES

Mayor Hodson called the closed session to order at 5:05 p.m. Present were Committee Members Cafero, O'Donoghue, Deputy Mayor Pfrommer, Mayor Hodson, Township Administrator Markulic, Deputy Township Administrator Mayfield, Township Solicitor Friedman, and Township Clerk Tedesco. Committeeman Ellis was absent and excused from the meeting due to medical reasons.

LITIGATION

Turf Field

Administrator Markulic recommended that the Township submit an application to The Pineland's Commission if the Township Committee wishes to move forward with the Canale Park Turf Field project. A discussion ensued about the cost of the project, funding options, use of the fields and the required maintenance of the turf's surface. The consensus was to submit an application to The Pinelands Commission at this time and to use proceeds from the sale of a cell tower to offset the cost of the turf fields.

PERSONNEL

Deputy Township Administrator Position

The Township Committee interviewed Thomas J. D'Intino for the position of Deputy Township Administrator. Mr. D'Intino provided an overview of his work history in law enforcement after which members of Township Committee and Administrator asked follow up questions. At the completion of the interview, Administrator Markulic advised that Mr. D'Intino is related to Township Engineer Watkins. Township Committee members asked if this relationship would preclude employing Mr. D'Intino. Deputy Mayfield advised that he did not find any reference in the code book that would preclude the hiring of Mr. D'Intino. Township Solicitor Friedman said that he does not believe this would be a conflict as the Township Committee directs the Township Engineer. Township Committee members directed Administrator Markulic to present an offer of employment to Mr. D'Intino.

There being no further business, motion Pfrommer second O'Donoghue, the meeting was reconvened to the public session at 6:07 p.m. All members present voted in the affirmative.
