MINUTES

Teamsters Contract Ratification

Administrator Markulic referred to her memo previously distributed to the governing body and briefly reviewed the changes made, such as time and a half for dispatchers who work on holidays, stipends for TAC Officer's and mechanics at Public Works who hold certifications. Also, the Township will pay for Class A, CDL Tanker endorsement certifications, whether new or for a renewal and any costs associated with the certification. Any new hires with this endorsement will be hired at a Step 2 on the salary chart. The governing body had no objections to the contract.

Deputy Administrator Position

Administrator Markulic provided an update on the applications she has received thus far for the position and said the posting deadline is November 9th.
