PURPOSE: The purpose of this policy is to provide clear direction and guidance concerning the personal use of social media, web-pages and related networking sites by both sworn and non-sworn members of the police department.

POLICY: While department personnel have a right to maintain personal web- pages and are free to express themselves through the use of social media outlets as private citizens, their status as members of the Paterson Police Department requires that the content of any posting not be in violation of existing agency policy, procedure or directive nor shall it compromise the integrity of any investigation, be contrary to any law nor bring the department or any of its members into disrepute.

I. DEFINITIONS:

Blog: A self-published diary or commentary on a particular topic that may allow visitors to post responses, reactions, or comments. The term is short for "Web log."

Page: The specific portion of a social media website where content is displayed, and managed by an individual or individuals with administrator rights.

Post: Content an individual shares on a social media site or the act of publishing content on a site.

Profile: Information that a user provides about himself or herself on a social networking site.

Social Media: A category of internet-based resources that integrate user-generated content and user participation. This includes, but is not limited to, social networking sites (Facebook, Myspace), microblogging sites (Twitter, Nixle), photo- and video- sharing sites (Flickr, YouTube), wikis (Wikipedia), blogs and news sites (Digg, Reddit).

Social Networks: Online platforms where users can create profiles, share information, and socialize with others using a range of technologies.

Speech: Expression or communication of thoughts or opinions in spoken words, in writing, by expressive conduct, symbolism, photographs, videotape, or related forms of communication.

Web 2.0: The second generation of the World Wide Web focused on shareable, user- generated content, rather than static web pages. Some use this term interchangeably with social media.

Wiki: Web page(s) that can be edited collaboratively.

II. PROCEDURE FOR USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA & WEB-PAGES:

Department members are free to utilize the defined forms of social media while acting as "private citizens" except that by virtue of their employment all personnel must remain keenly aware and be cognizant of the following as it pertains to their personal use of social media outlets:

- A. Since employees have the potential to be called as a witness in court proceedings related to their employment as a member of this agency, personnel must be mindful that their credibility and character are subject to challenge and potential impeachment based upon the nature of postings on personal web pages or websites from any time, past or present.
- B. Employees must be cognizant of the potential adverse consequences internet postings may have on their credibility during cross-examination in court, future employment or promotional opportunities and possible embarrassment in the media.

III. PROHIBITIONS

Department members shall be strictly prohibited from the following acts as they pertain to postings on and utilization of social media.

- A. Conduct both on and off duty is subject to the rules and regulations of the police department. Any activity that discredits the reputation of the Paterson Police Department or any of its employees or members shall be strictly prohibited.
- B. Members of the department shall not express personal opinions on official agency policy or positions.
- C. Any item, object or materials that could be used or reasonably misconstrued as official agency sanctioned property shall not be used or depicted on any personal internet posting without the expressed written permission of the Chief of Police.

These items, objects or materials shall include:

1. Photographs
2. Images or Likenesses
3. Pictures, reproductions or other depictions of agency uniforms, badges, patches, issued equipment, weapons, marked or unmarked police units, reports, evidence, crime scene or crash scene photographs.

IV. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

All members of this agency are charged with the responsibility of promptly reporting any information they may have regarding violations of this policy and procedure, through the chain of command, to the Office of Professional Standards. Members of this agency who violate any provision of this policy shall be subject to swift disciplinary action. Those members, who in violating this policy, compromise the integrity of any criminal or administrative investigation or engage in postings or writings that slander the professional reputation or credibility of the department or any of its members may also be subjected to civil and/or criminal liability.

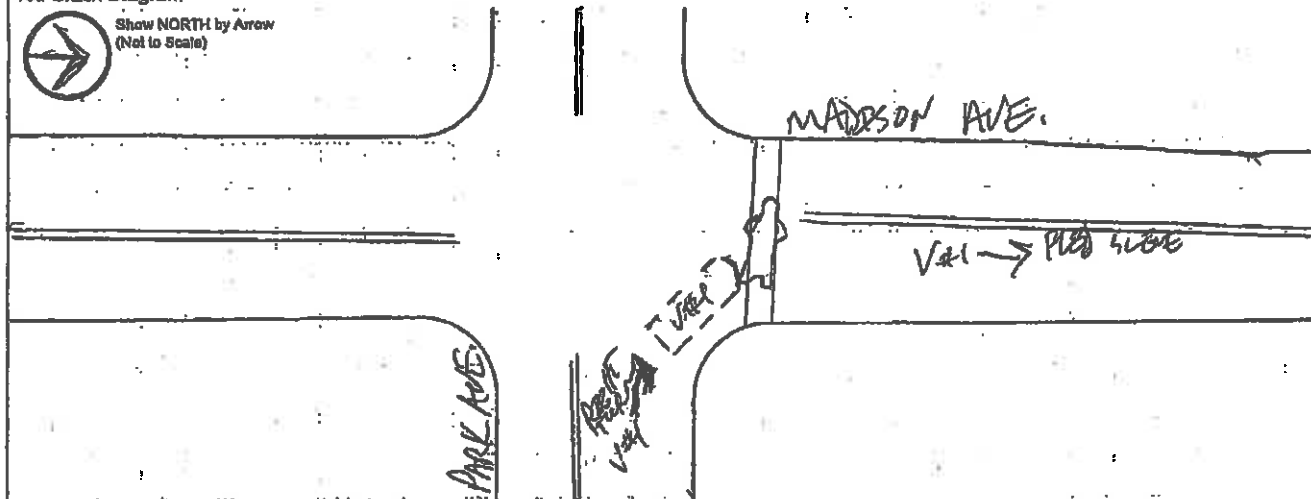

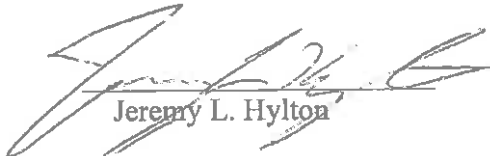

NARRATIVE ON REVERSE

PARTS / OF

Dispatched to the area of Chamberlain Avenue and West Broadway (Wells Fargo Bank) on a report of an attempted robbery. Upon arrival, these officers were met by the complainant, Victor Reyes, the witness, Mr. Luis Rodriguez, Unit #462, and Unit #126, who relayed that Mr. Reyes was the victim of an attempted robbery.

These officers spoke with Mr. Reyes(C), who relayed that he just left work and needed to go to the bank to withdraw cash. Mr. Reyes (C) parked his vehicle inside of the shopping center where the Wells Fargo was located (466 Chamberlain Avenue), exited his vehicle, and entered the bank. He proceeded to the ATM, withdrew \$60 in cash, and exited the bank. When Mr. Reyes (C) was approximately 5 feet from his vehicle; he noticed a black male (wearing grey sweat pants and sweatshirt) walking towards him. Mr. Reyes (C) was not alarmed as he relayed he did not think he was in danger. As Mr. Reyes (C) opened his car door, the suspect, from approximately 20 feet away, stated "Yo give me everything you got!" Mr. Reyes replied "No!" entered his vehicle and turned it on in an attempt to get to safety. The suspect then pulled out a silver handgun from his waistband, pointed it at the vehicle from the same distance, and fire 1 shot towards Mr. Reyes(C). Mr. Reyes (C) relayed he was not struck by the bullet, but it did strike his vehicle. He put the vehicle in reverse, and pressed his foot really hard on the gas in fear for his life, causing his vehicle to spin around and reverse into the building next door, Oritani Bank (460 Chamberlain Avenue), causing heavy damage to the rear of his vehicle and structural damage to the business. Mr. Reyes (C) then looked in the direction of the suspect and noticed he entered a minivan (possibly blue or silver), and drove off, making a right onto West Broadway, towards Union Avenue. It was at this point in time that Mr. Reyes (C) called 911 and provided a brief description of the suspect and vehicle (Black male, wearing all grey sweats, inside of a mini van, possibly blue or silver, with the back right tail light broken). Mr. Reyes (C) showed no signs of injury and denied medical treatment on scene.

These officers then spoke with Mr. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~, who witnessed the incident occur. Broadway when we observed a tan/silver minivan turn onto Memorial Drive in front of our police vehicle. The minivan had damage to the right taillight and had two occupants. A motor vehicle stop was conducted on the above vehicle at Memorial Drive and W. Broadway. The vehicle was identified as a brown 2002 Pontiac Montana bearing NJ registration (G34HJX). As this Detective approached the driver, illuminating the interior of the vehicle, I immediately saw a black handgun at her feet. The driver later identified as Iesha Brown was ordered out of the vehicle at gunpoint. Miss Brown complied and was immediately placed into custody with assisting Patrol unit 109, Officer Avila. Simultaneously, Detective Herrmann ordered the passenger out, later identified as Terrance Douglas-Davis Jr., who was also placed into custody without incident.

In plain view on the above vehicle's center console was a black mask and on the driver side floor was a black handgun. Unit 107 arrived on scene and secured the vehicle, awaiting Classic Towing, to remove the vehicle to the Paterson Police Secure Hanger for CSI processing.

Unit 105, Officer Finch, arrived on scene with the victim from 460 Chamberlain Ave, later identified as Victor Reyes Jr, to conduct a show-up.
