The Township of Wyckoff received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on November 12, 2018. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is November 21, 2018. This response to your request is being provided to you on the fifth (5th) business day after receipt of the request.

Your OPRA request seeks:

"I am requesting any and all information related to Janice Wolfe of Merlin's KIDS & United K9 Professionals. Whether it be payroll, criminal, complaints, lawsuits, tax fraud, animal neglect, and/or any information pertaining to her organizations including any names of employees or board members."

The response to your request is as follows:

1. Under N.J.S.A.47:1A-1.1 "Criminal Investigatory Record" anything "criminal" is exempt from disclosure.
2. After doing a search, we have no information in our system related to Merlin's Kids and or United K9 Professionals.
3. The Wyckoff Police Department can only provide you with Municipal Ordinance Violation complaints pertaining to dogs barking and dogs running at large. There are fifteen (15) Municipal Ordinance Violation complaints. On each report/document some information for the persons involved has been redacted. Reason for redaction: It is our responsibility and obligation to safeguard from public access a citizen's personal information and to prevent unwanted solicitation and contact under Executive Order 21.

On Saturday April 1, 2017 at approximately 1025 hours, I made contact with the owner of the dogs involved, Mrs Janice Wolfe.

I explained to Mrs Wolfe why I was contacting her and the complaint made the morning earlier. Mrs Wolfe stated she has a company which cares for her very expensive show dogs when she is not home,(which is very frequently). Mrs Wolfe further stated a new employee accidentally left the rear door of the residence ajar upon leaving that morning and "one" of the dogs got out and couldn't get back into the residence.

I advised Mrs Wolfe that the officer on scene stated there were several dogs in the rear yard that morning, and she denied that was possible. When I further advised her the officer stated there were several residents in the roadway complaining about the ongoing issue, Mrs Wolfe became very defensive and stated "I know who complained, it was my next door neighbors". Specifically the female homeowner.

I explained this has been an ongoing issue with her dogs barking and roaming the neighborhood as well. Again Mrs Wolfe became very defensive and denied her dogs had ever roamed the neighborhood. She stated it was a similar dog from the neighborhood which was mistaken for one of her dogs, and TYCO Animal Control can verify this information.

On May 31, 2017 at approximately 0604 hours PO Flim and I were dispatched to [REDACTED] for a welfare check on the resident. Upon arrival we were met outside by multiple neighbors who advised that the resident of [REDACTED] has had their dogs outside for over an hour in the pouring rain, and they would not stop barking. They further stated that this has been an ongoing issue for the past few years. As we approached the house I was able to hear 2 or 3 separate dogs continuously barking in the rear yard. Upon knocking on the door we received no answer from the resident and requested dispatch to attempt to reach out via telephone. After approximately 5 minutes Dispatch advised us that the resident was home but was unable to come to the door. At this time Sgt. Tully advised us to call back in service, that an Officer from the day shift will respond later and speak with the resident to follow up. No further incident

Carol informed me that she was going to give notice to the Wolfe's one last time that they need to quiet their dogs. Also, if there is more than the 4 registered dogs on premises, then they are in violation and will be cited. We knocked several times on the door without an answer. Carol was certain that Mr. Wolfe was home, but refusing to answer the door. She will attempt to contact them by phone and give them the last warning. Regarding the continuous dog barking, Carol recommended the complainant sign a complaint and subpoena all the neighbors to court. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the dogs and the owners (Janice and Blaire Wolfe) have been a nuisance to the neighborhood for some time. I was familiar with the home in question as I responded to [REDACTED] Louisa Ave a month prior for a complaint about the dogs being at large. At that time two Rhodesian Ridgebacks had ran free from the yard and growled at the neighbor's nanny. They continued to run around the neighborhood for a long period of time until finally captured by Ms. Wolfe.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated that TYCO had been previously involved and restricted Janice Wolfe to allowing only one dog out in the yard at a time. She was also apparently restricted to four dogs on the property at any time. Mr. [REDACTED] stated what prompted his complaint today was seeing four or more dogs in the rear yard at once. They were also allegedly barking. He added that a mother and daughter walked by the rear of the property and the dogs allegedly barked menacingly at them and it seemed to frighten them both. Mr. [REDACTED] stated the dogs bark often and for long periods of time. They were not in they yard or barking while I was present.

Mr. [REDACTED] also added that he felt the property was in a deplorable condition. I spoke with him at the rear of the property on the Kingston St side. I observed the yard was unkempt and had some remnants of a construction project that was not complete. There was no grass and it did not appear as if the owners had laid down seed or were attempting to grow any. The soil was rocky and muddy. There was a large pile of dirt on the south side. I could easily smell an odor of dog feces emanating from the yard, although I was unable to see any feces on the ground. I further observed a black chain link fence that was damaged. It was propped up and secured with a string to a white vinyl fence. There was also a piece of cardboard and several other objects that appeared to be placed in front of the fence in an attempt to block the dogs from escaping. A check of the history shows that PO Groslinger observed this same damaged fence in November of 2010 (blotter # 11352-10) and it is yet to be repaired.

The homeowners were not home (Mr. [REDACTED] stated they rarely are). However, PO Murphy met with [REDACTED] who was leaving the property as we arrived. [REDACTED] stated he was hired by Ms. Wolfe to let the dogs out. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that Ms. Wolfe has seven dogs inside the home. Mr. [REDACTED] was advised of the complaint and will be mindful while letting the dogs out in the rear yard in the future. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he did not wish to sign complaints for the barking dogs.
