RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXTRAORDINARY, UNSPECIFIABLE SERVICES CONTRACT TO THE ANZILOTTI GROUP

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oakland may award contracts for Extraordinary, Unspecifiable Services ("EUS") without competitive bids in accordance with the requirements of NJSA 40A:115(1)(a)(ii) and the NJAC 5:34.2; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Oakland wishes to assess operations within the Oakland Police Department by reviewing, Standard Operating Procedures, Policies and Procedures, rules and regulations, to assess departmental I.T. and Radio communications and to assist with professional development; and

WHEREAS, The Anzilotti Group submitted a proposal to the Borough of Oakland to provide such consulting services for an amount not to exceed Eighty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$83,500.00); and

WHEREAS, The Anzilotti Group has submitted their Political Contribution Disclosure and Business Entity Disclosure certifications in accordance with the law; and

WHEREAS, this resolution and the EUS contract shall be kept on file and available for public inspection in the Office of the Borough Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland, County of Bergen, as follows:

1. The Anzilotti Group of 20 Wilsey Square, Ridgewood, NJ 07450 is hereby awarded a contract in the amount not to exceed \$83,500.00 for consulting services related to the efficient and professional operation of the Oakland Police Department, in accordance with the proposal attached.
2. A Certification of Funds has been prepared by the Chief Financial Officer for the said contract assuring that a sufficient appropriation in budget account # 6-01-20-155-100 exists to fund the purchases authorized in this resolution as an express and mandatory condition of the award of this contract.
3. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as an "Extraordinary Unspecifiable Service" in accordance with the NJSA 40A:11-5(1)(a) of the Local Public Contracts Law because it is not reasonably possible to draft specifications for these consulting services as an extensive knowledge and a proven reputation in the field is required.
4. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the contract documents necessary to effectuate the award of this contract. The Borough Attorney shall review any and all contractual documents prepared in the furtherance of this award.
