



**BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN
RESOLUTION 2024-186**



**Establishing a Mount Laurel Subcommittee to Assist the Borough in Complying with its
Affordable Housing Obligations**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the principle established by the state Supreme Court's Mount Laurel decision, the Borough of Milltown has a constitutional obligation to provide its "fair share" of very low-, low- and moderate-income housing; and

AND WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the Borough's continuing efforts to implement its Round 4 Housing Element and Fair Share Plan and to enable the Borough to begin planning for the Round 5, the Borough Council believes it is in the Borough's best interest to form a "Mount Laurel Subcommittee" to meet periodically to address the manner in which the Borough will fulfill its Mount Laurel obligations.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Milltown, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

The Borough of Milltown hereby creates a "Mount Laurel Subcommittee" to consider and address the Borough's continuing obligation to provide opportunities for the provision of very low-, low- and moderate-income housing in the Borough.

In particular the Mount Laurel subcommittee shall (a) ensure that the Borough continues to properly implement its Third Round Court approved Housing Element and Fair Share Plan; (b) investigate facts and issues relevant to the Borough's satisfaction of its affordable housing obligations; (c) review and discuss draft ordinances, resolutions and other relevant documents associated with the Borough's Housing Element and Fair Share Plan; (d) ensure that the Borough is preparing to address the upcoming Fourth Round, which will begin on July 1, 2025, and (e) discuss issues relevant to the Borough's efforts to address future affordable housing obligations as defined by the courts, the legislature, and/or various state agencies.

The Subcommittee's membership shall be made up of

- a. Mayor
- b. 2 Council Members
- c. Borough Administrator
- d. Member of the Planning Board
- e. The Borough Attorney
- f. The Borough Affordable Housing Counsel
- g. The Borough Planner
- h. 2 residents of Milltown Borough



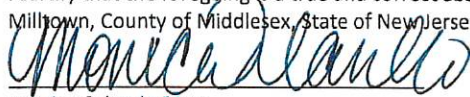
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4. Subcommittee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Borough Council. The Borough Council shall annually review the Subcommittee membership and in its discretion shall make appointments as necessary to maintain the Subcommittee's full membership.
5. The Subcommittee shall meet periodically to consider and address the Borough's affordable housing obligations, and shall make recommendations, as appropriate to the Borough Council, as to how the Borough should satisfy those obligations.
6. The Subcommittee shall remain in existence until dissolved or terminated by the Borough Council.
7. This resolution shall take effect immediately, according to law.
