

RESOLUTION R.564-092024

EXPLANATION: A Resolution providing the Municipal Council's advice and consent to the appointment by the Mayor of Malia Reichman as a Judge of the Municipal Court of the Township.

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the "**Township**") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey and desires to appoint the judge of the Municipal Court of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the judge of the Municipal Court of the Township shall have, possess and exercise all the jurisdictions, powers, functions and duties which are or may be conferred by law and the applicable rules of the Supreme Court of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to appoint Malia Reichmann as judge of the Municipal Court of the Township;

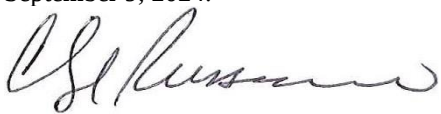
WHEREAS, the Municipal Council seeks to provide its advice and consent to the aforesaid re-appointment, in accordance with Section 2-94.1 of the Township Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Malia Reichmann shall be appointed as judges of the Municipal Court of the Township, each for a three (3) year term, effective immediately, with compensation as determined by the Mayor and Municipal Council and approved by subsequent ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Municipal Council hereby provides its advice and consent to the Mayor's appointment of Malia Reichmann, as judges of the Municipal Court of the Township, each for a three (3) year term, effective immediately, at compensation as determined by the Mayor and Municipal Council and approved by subsequent ordinance.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
