

RESOLUTION R.239-042023

EXPLANATION: A Resolution providing the Municipal Council's advice and consent to the appointment by the Mayor of Asma Warsi, Esq. as judge of the Municipal Court of the Township.

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the "**Township**") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey and desires to appoint the judge of the Municipal Court of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the judge of the Municipal Court of the Township shall have, possess and exercise all the jurisdictions, powers, functions and duties which are or may be conferred by law and the applicable rules of the Supreme Court of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the resignation of Judge Parag Patel there is a vacancy in Office of Municipal Court judge; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Asma Warsi, subject to the advice and consent of Council, as judge of the Municipal Court of the Township to fill the unexpired term of Judge Patel; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council seeks to provide its advice and consent to the aforesaid re-appointment, in accordance with Section 2-94.1 of the Township Code of Ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Township Council hereby provides its advice and consent to the Mayor's appointment of Asma Warsi as judge of the Municipal Court of the Township, for a term to expire on July 31, 2024, at compensation as determined by the Mayor and Municipal Council by ordinance.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
