_____ Administrative or technical information regarding computer hardware, software and networks which, if disclosed would jeopardize computer security. Emergency or security information or procedures for any buildings or facility which, if disclosed, would jeopardize security of the building or facility or persons therein. Security measures and surveillance techniques which, if disclosed, would create a risk to the safety of persons, property, electronic data or software. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1

_____ Limitations to convicts - personal information pertaining to the person's victim or the victim's family, including but not limited to a victim's home address, home telephone number, work or school address, work telephone number, social security account number, medical history or any other identifying information. *Information may be released only if the information is necessary to assist in the defense of the requestor. A determination that the information is necessary to assist in the requestor's defense shall be made by the court upon motion by the requestor or his representative.* N.J.S.A. 47:1A-2.2

 Ongoing investigations - any records pertaining to an investigation in progress by any public agency if disclosure of such records or records shall be detrimental to the public interest. *This provision shall not be construed to allow any public agency to prohibit access to a record of that agency that was open for public inspection, examination, or copying before the investigation commenced.* N.J.S.A. 47:1A-3.a
