1. Privacy Interest - "a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizen's personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizen's reasonable expectation of privacy." See Burnett v. Cnty. of Bergen, 198 N.J. 408 (2009)

The following are codified at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1:

2. Inter-agency or intra-agency advisory, consultative or deliberative material (Note: refers generally to draft documents or documents used in a deliberative process)
3. Legislative records. Specifically:
 - a. information received by a member of the Legislature from a constituent or information held by a member of the Legislature concerning a constituent, including but not limited to information in written form or contained in any email or computer data base, or in any telephone record whatsoever, unless it is information the constituent is required by law to transmit;
 - b. any memorandum, correspondence, notes, report or other communication prepared by, or for, the specific use of a member of the Legislature in the course of the member's official duties, except that this provision shall not apply to an otherwise publicly-accessible report which is required by law to be submitted to the Legislature or its members
4. Medical examiner records – photographs, negatives, print, videotapes taken at the scene of death or in the course of postmortem examination or autopsy, except:
 - a. when used in a criminal action or proceeding in this State which relates to the death of that person,
 - b. for the use as a court of this State permits, by order after good cause has been shown and after written notification of the request for the court order has been served at least five days before the order is made upon the county prosecutor for the county in which the post mortem examination or autopsy occurred,
 - c. for use in the field of forensic pathology or for use in medical or scientific education or research.

d. for use by any law enforcement agency in this State or any other state or federal law enforcement agency.

5. Criminal investigatory records - records which are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file that are held by a law enforcement agency which pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding. (Note: N.J.S.A. 47:1A-3 b lists specific criminal investigatory information which must be disclosed).

The portion of any criminal record concerning a person's detection, apprehension, arrest, detention, trial or disposition for unlawful manufacturing, distributing, or dispensing, or possessing or having under control with intent to manufacture, distribute, or dispense, marijuana or hashish in violation of paragraph (11) of subsection b. of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5, or a lesser amount of marijuana or hashish in violation of paragraph (12) of subsection b. of that section, or a violation of either of those paragraphs and a violation of subsection a. of section 1 of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7 or subsection a. of section 1 of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7.1 for distributing, dispensing, or possessing, or having under control with intent to distribute or dispense, on or within 1,000 feet of any school property, or on or within 500 feet of the real property comprising a public housing facility, public park, or public building, or for obtaining, possessing, using, being under the influence of, or failing to make lawful disposition of marijuana or hashish in violation of paragraph (3) or (4) of subsection a., or subsection b., or subsection c. of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10, or for a violation of any of those provisions and a violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-2 for using or possessing with intent to use drug paraphernalia with that marijuana or hashish,

6. Victims' records:

- a. an individually identifiable file or document held by a victims' rights agency which pertains directly to a victim of a crime except that a victim of a crime shall have access to the victim's own records. "Victims' rights agency" means a public agency, or part thereof, the primary responsibility of which is providing services, including but not limited to food, shelter, or clothing, medical, psychiatric, psychological or legal services or referrals, information and referral services, counseling and support services, or financial services to victims of crimes, including victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, violent crime, child endangerment, child abuse or child neglect, and the Victims of Crime Compensation Board.
- b. any written OPRA request by a crime victim for a record to which the victim is entitled to access, including, but not limited to, any law enforcement agency report, domestic violence offense report, and temporary or permanent restraining order,

7. Personal firearms records:

- a. Except for use by any person authorized by law to have access to these records or for use by any government agency, including any court or law enforcement agency, for purposes of the administration of justice
- b. Personal identifying information received by the Division of Fish and Wildlife in the Department of Environmental Protection in connection with the issuance of any license authorizing hunting with a firearm. For the purposes of this paragraph,

personal identifying information shall include, but not be limited to, identity, name, address, social security number, telephone number, fax number, driver's license number, email address, or social media address of any applicant or licensee.

8. Trade secrets and proprietary commercial or financial information obtained from any source. Includes data processing software obtained by a public agency under a licensing agreement which prohibits its disclosure.
9. Any record within the attorney-client privilege. This paragraph does not allow for a denial of attorney invoices in their totality; however, redactions may apply for information contained in the invoices that are protected under the privilege.
10. Administrative or technical information regarding computer hardware, software and networks which, if disclosed would jeopardize computer security.
11. Emergency or security information or procedures for any buildings or facility which, if disclosed, would jeopardize security of the building or facility or persons therein
12. Security measures and surveillance techniques which, if disclosed, would create a risk to the safety of persons, property, electronic data or software.
13. Information which, if disclosed, would give an advantage to competitors or bidders
14. Information generated by or on behalf of public employers or public employees in connection with:
 - a. Any sexual harassment complaint filed with a public employer;
 - b. Any grievance filed by or against an individual; or
 - c. Collective negotiations, including documents and statements of strategy or negotiating position.
15. Information which is a communication between a public agency and its insurance carrier, administrative service organization or risk management office.
16. Information which is to be kept confidential pursuant to court order.
17. Certificate of honorable discharge issued by the United States government (Form DD-214, NBG-22, or other form) filed with a public agency, except that a veteran or the veteran's spouse or surviving spouse shall have access to the veteran's own records.
18. Any copy of an oath of allegiance, oath of office, or any affirmation for incoming, current, and former officers and employees in State, County, or municipal government, and including members all members of the Legislative, Executive, and Judicial branches of government, except that Full name, title, and oath date are not confidential.
19. Personal identifying information. Specifically:
 - a. Social security numbers, except that a social security number contained in a record required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file by a public agency shall be disclosed when access to the document or disclosure of that information is not otherwise prohibited by State or federal law, regulation or order or by State statute, resolution of either or both houses of the Legislature, Executive Order of the Governor, rule of court or regulation promulgated under the authority of any statute or executive order of the Governor.
 - b. In accordance with section 2 of N.J.S.A. 47:1B-2, commonly known as "Daniel's Law", that portion of any document which discloses the home address, whether a

primary or secondary residence, of any active, formerly active, or retired judicial officer, prosecutor, or law enforcement officer, or, as defined in section 1 of N.J.S.A. 47:1B-1, any immediate family member thereof.

- c. Credit card numbers.
- d. Unlisted telephone numbers
- e. Drivers' license numbers.

Except for:

- a. any government agency, including any court or law enforcement agency, in carrying out its functions,
 - b. or any private person or entity acting on behalf thereof,
 - c. or any private person or entity seeking to enforce payment of court-ordered child support: except with respect to the disclosure of driver information by the Division of Motor Vehicles as permitted by section 2 of P.L. 1997, c. 188 (C. 39-2-3.4);
20. List of persons in need of special assistant during an emergency maintained at either the municipal or county level in accordance with section 1 of P.L. 2017, c. 266 (C.40:48-2-67) or section 6 of P.L. 2011, c. 178 (C.App.A:9-43.13).
21. Certain records of higher education institutions:
- a. Pedagogical, scholarly and/or academic research records and/or the specific details of any research project, except that a custodian may not deny inspection of a government record or part thereof that gives the name, title, expenditures, source and amounts of funding and date when the final project summary of any research will be available.
 - b. Test questions, scoring keys and other examination data pertaining to the administration of an examination for employment or academic examination.
 - c. Records of pursuit of charitable contributions or records containing the identity of a donor of a gift if the donor requires non-disclosure of the donor's identity as a condition of making the gift provided that the donor has not received any benefits of or from the institution of higher education in connection with such gift other than a request for memorialization or dedication.
 - d. Valuable or rare collections of books and/or documents obtained by gift, grant, bequest or devise conditioned upon limited public access.
 - e. Information contained on individual admission applications.
 - f. Information concerning student records or grievance or disciplinary proceedings against a student to the extent disclosure would reveal the identity of the student
22. Biotechnology trade secrets.

The following are codified at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-2.2

23. Limitations to convicts - personal information pertaining to the person's victim or the victim's family, including but not limited to a victim's home address, home telephone number, work or school address, work telephone number, social security account number, medical history or any other identifying information. Information may be released only if the information is necessary to assist in the defense of the requestor. A determination that the information is necessary to assist in the requestor's defense shall be made by the court upon motion by the requestor or his representative.

The following is codified at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-3(a):

24. Ongoing investigations - any records pertaining to an investigation in progress by any public agency if disclosure of such record or records shall be detrimental to the public interest. This provision shall not be construed to allow any public agency to prohibit access to a record of that agency that was open for public inspection, examination, or copying before the investigation commenced.

The following is codified at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(k):

25. Public defender records that relate to the handling of any case, unless authorized by law, court order, or the State Public Defender.

The following is codified at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9(a)-(b):

26. Upholds exemptions contained in other State or federal statutes and regulations, Executive Orders of the Governor, Rules of Court, Constitution of this State, or judicial case law.

The following are codified at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10:

27. Personnel and pension records, except specific information identified as follows:
- a. An individual's name, title, position, salary, payroll record, length of service, date of separation and the reason for such separation, and the amount and type of any pension received.

- b. When required to be disclosed by another law, when disclosure is essential to the performance of official duties of a person duly authorized by this State or the United States, or when authorized by an individual in interest.
- c. Data contained in information which disclose conformity with specific experiential, educational or medical qualifications required for government employment or for receipt of a public pension, but not including any detailed medical or psychological information

The following are in accordance with OPRA's "catch-all" exemption at N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9, the following executive orders also apply as exemptions under OPRA:

28. Executive Order No. 21 (McGreevey 2002)

- a. Records where inspection, examination or copying would substantially interfere with the State's ability to protect and defend the State and its citizens against acts of sabotage or terrorism, or which, if disclosed, would materially increase the risk or consequences of potential acts of sabotage or terrorism.
- b. Records exempted from disclosure by State agencies' promulgated rules are exempt from disclosure by this Order.
- c. Executive Orders No. 9 (Hughes), 11 (Byrne), 79 (Byrne) and 69 (Whitman) are hereby continued to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this Executive Order.
- d. Executive Order No. 9 (Hughes) exemptions that are still active:
 - i. Questions on examinations required to be conducted by any State or local governmental agency;
 - ii. Personnel and pension records (same as N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10);
 - iii. Records concerning morbidity, mortality and reportable diseases of named persons required to be made, maintained or kept by any State or local governmental agency;
 - iv. Records which are required to be made, maintained or kept by any State or local governmental agency which would disclose information concerning illegitimacy;
 - v. Fingerprint cards, plates and photographs and other similar criminal investigation records which are required to be made, maintained or kept by any State or local governmental agency;
 - vi. Criminal records required to be made, maintained and kept pursuant to the provisions of R. S. 53:1-20.1 and R. S. 53:1-20.2;
 - vii. Personal property tax returns required to be filed under the provisions of Chapter 4 of Title 54 of the Revised Statutes, and
 - viii. Records relating to petitions for executive clemency.
- e. Executive Order No. 11 (Byrne) exemptions are the same as N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10
- f. Executive Order No. 79 (Byrne) exemptions are the similar to above under N.J.S.A. 47:1A-11.

- g. Executive Order No. 69 (Whitman) exemptions that are still active: Fingerprint cards, plates and photographs and similar criminal investigation records that are required to be made, maintained or kept by any State or local governmental agency.

29. Executive Order No. 26 (McGreevey 2002)

- a. Certain records maintained by the Office of the Governor:
 - i. Any record made, maintained, kept on file or received by the Office of the Governor in the course of its official business which is subject to an executive privilege or grant of confidentiality established or recognized by the Constitution of this State, statute, court rules or judicial case law.
 - ii. All portions of records, including electronic communications, that contain advisory, consultative or deliberative information or other records protected by a recognized privilege.
 - iii. All portions of records containing information provided by an identifiable natural person outside the Office of the Governor which contains information that the sender is not required by law to transmit and which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy if disclosed.
 - iv. If any of the foregoing records shall contain information not exempted by the provision of the Open Public Records Act or the preceding subparagraphs, in such event, that portion of the record so exempt shall be deleted or excised and access to the remainder of the record shall be promptly permitted.
- b. Resumes, applications for employment or other information concerning job applicants while a recruitment search is ongoing. The resumes of successful candidates shall be disclosed once the successful candidate is hired. The resumes of unsuccessful candidates may be disclosed after the search has been concluded and the position has been filled, but only where the unsuccessful candidate has consented to such disclosure.
- c. Records of complaints and investigations undertaken pursuant to the Model Procedures for Internal Complaints Alleging Discrimination, Harassment or Hostile Environments.
- d. Information relating to medical, psychiatric or psychological history, diagnosis, treatment or evaluation.
- e. Information in a personal income or other tax return.
- f. Information describing a natural person's finances, income, assets, liabilities, net worth, bank balances, financial history or activities, or creditworthiness, except as otherwise required by law to be disclosed.
- g. Test questions, scoring keys and other examination data pertaining to the administration of an examination for public employment or licensing.

While speaking with Mr. Sankowich, he indicated that he was coming around the bend in the roadway and upon clearing it observed the black pickup truck backing into the driveway of ● Main Street. After speaking with Mr. Sankowich, I approached Mr. Jurgensen who appeared to be upset and pacing toward the back portion of his driveway. While speaking with Mr. Jurgensen, he related that he was backing his boat and trailer into his driveway. He further indicated that Mr. Sankowich came around the bend and struck his boat trailer. While Mr. Jurgensen was searching for his license, registration and insurance at my request, a member of the Waretown First Aid approached and I advised them that Mr. Sankowich was the injured party. After overhearing this, Mr. Jurgensen stated that after the accident he shoved Mr. Sankowich. I asked Mr. Jurgensen if Mr. Sankowich fell back into his vehicle and hit his head and he confirmed that he did. Throughout speaking with Mr. Jurgensen, he appeared visibly frustrated and upset over the accident. At times he cursed and threw his hands up in frustration.

While Mr. Sankowich was being treated by Waretown First Aid for his injury, I again asked him to explain the incident. Mr. Sankowich explained that after coming around the bend he attempted to slow down. He continued to relate that after noticing the vehicle wasn't slowing down, he activated his breaks harder causing the vehicle wheels to lock up. Mr. Sankowich stated to prevent hitting the truck he swerved into the grass and struck the boat trailer. He continued to explain that after the accident, Mr. Jurgensen got out of his vehicle first and threw a beer in the rear of his truck. Mr. Sankowich indicated that Mr. Jurgensen threw a punch at him and then pushed him, causing Mr. Sankowich to fall backwards and hit his head on the top portion of his vehicle. Mr. Sankowich stated that at no point during the altercation did he put his hands on Mr. Jurgensen.

After speaking with Mr. Sankowich, I again approached Mr. Jurgensen and began to speak with him about the incident. During the conversation, Mr. Jurgensen stated that after Mr. Sankowich hit his trailer, Mr. Sankowich exited his vehicle first and confronted him. Mr. Jurgensen again stated that he then shoved Mr. Sankowich causing him to fall back into his vehicle and hit his head. After Mr. Jurgensen explained the incident, I advised him that he was going to be charged with simple assault for shoving Mr. Sankowich and causing injury to him. Mr. Jurgensen was cooperative and Cpl. Cicero and I agreed to wait until his wife arrived home to place him under arrest.

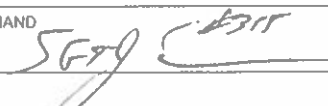
After speaking with Mr. Jurgensen, I completed a V.I.N.E. form with Mr. Sankowich and he was transported to Community Medical Center for further medical evaluation. Following completion of the crash investigation, the vehicle Mr. Sankowich was operating was retrieved from the scene by his mother. I then placed Mr. Jurgensen under arrest. He was placed in handcuffs, double locked and secured in the rear seat of patrol vehicle 20-07. Upon arrival at police headquarters, Mr. Jurgensen was removed from handcuffs, searched and placed in processing area one.

I advised Mr. Jurgensen of his Miranda Rights and he waived in writing. After finger printing and photographing, Mr. Jurgensen's Public Safety Assessment was completed which displayed a score of one for new criminal activity and one for failure to appear and recommended his charge be placed on a complaint summons. Subsequently, Mr. Jurgensen was processed and released with the following summons pending a scheduled court date.

After Mr. Sankowich was released from the hospital, I responded to his residence and photographed his injuries. While at his residence, Mr. Sankowich showed me a scratch on his left cheek which he stated was from when Mr. Jurgensen had punched him. Mr. Jurgensen was not a member of the United States Armed Forces and the above events were memorialized on the assigned body worn cameras of Cpl. Cicero and I.

once more. As I continued behind the suspect vehicle, I observed both its driver side front and rear tires operate over the double yellow line once again before I activated my overhead emergency lights of my patrol vehicle in order to initiate a motor vehicle stop with the suspect vehicle. The suspect vehicle came to a stop nearest the intersection of Route 9 and Main Street North.

At this time, I advised police dispatch of the location of the motor vehicle stop, the vehicle's registration and description, number of occupants, and the reason for the stop. I then exited my patrol vehicle in order to make contact with the operator of the motor vehicle at the passenger side front window of the vehicle. Upon making contact with the driver, I identified myself and advised the male operator that the reason I conducted the motor vehicle stop was due to him operating the motor vehicle over the white fog line and swerving on the roadway. I subsequently requested his driver's license, vehicle registration, and the vehicle's insurance documentation. It should be noted that during this time, the male operator's eyes appeared to be both watery and bloodshot, and his speech slow and ~~in~~ slurred. I then asked the male operator identified as Daniel Augustino DOB 07/08/1991 of ██████████ Skylark Drive, Toms River, NJ, 08755 if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages throughout the evening, at which point he stated yes. When asked how much he consumed, Augustino stated "a couple Miller Lite beers and a shot" at the Lighthouse Tavern while playing billiards. Augustino related he had consumed his last alcoholic beverage at approximately 2100 hours on 08/09/2023, approximately an hour prior to the motor vehicle stop. While speaking with Augustino, I observed a Miller Lite glass beer bottle lying on the front passenger seat floorboard of the vehicle. When asked, Augustino related the approximately half full Miller Lite bottle was from earlier in the day and related he may have been consuming it on his way back home to Toms River.

During this time, I requested Cpl. Cicero of this agency to respond to my location. It should be noted, while awaiting Cpl. Cicero to respond to my location, Augustino related he and his girlfriend had broken up, and he was having a rough day and messed up. Upon Cpl. Cicero's arrival, I approached the driver side of Augustino's motor vehicle and escorted him to the empty parking lot directly next to our location, in order to safely perform the Standard Field Sobriety Test.

Test #1. HGN.

This test was administered by Cpl. Cicero; see his supplemental report for additional details.

Test #2. Walk & Turn.

Results: While explaining the instructions to Augustino, he had difficulty maintaining the starting position of heel to toe contact and stepped out of the starting position several times and had to be instructed to get back into the starting position. When asked if he had any medical conditions or issues that would cause him to lose his balance while performing the test, Augustino stated no. Following the completion of instruction and demonstration, Augustino stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. While performing the test, Augustino did not make heel to toe contact on his first step, and when Augustino performed the third step, he lost his balance and stepped off the line placing his right foot next to his left, opposed to maintaining straight forward heel to toe contact as instructed. At this time, Augustino stopped performing the test and had to be instructed to continue, and after continuing with the test, Augustino did not make heel to toe contact on step six. During the turning phase, Augustino did not take several small steps as instructed but instead turned in one swift motion and lifted his front lead foot off of the ground opposed to keeping it on the ground as instructed. While returning, Augustino did not make heel to toe contact on steps two or four, and paused briefly after step four as he appeared frustrated. Augustino subsequently continued performing the test and did not make heel to toe contact on steps six or nine. At no point throughout the entirety of the test did Augustino keep his arms down at his side as instructed but instead had both arms raised greater than six inches from his side in order to maintain his balance.

Test #3. One Leg Stand.

Results: While giving instructions, Augustino did not maintain the starting position and placed his arms behind his back opposed to at his side as instructed. Following the completion of instruction and demonstration, Augustino stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. While performing the test, Augustino did not keep his arms down by his side and had both arms raised greater than six inches away from his body. I instructed Augustino to put his arms down by his side, at which point he placed both arms behind his back. I subsequently repeated to Augustino to put his arms down by his side at which point he did so. While continuing with the test, Augustino placed his raised foot on the ground in order to maintain his balance opposed to keeping his foot raised. At this time and approximately 20 seconds into the test, Augustino stopped performing the test then attempted to

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continue, then stopped again. When I instructed Augustino to continue, he stated "No, I messed up, I messed up, I'm not going to lie, I messed up."

Following the completion of the test, when asked if he believes he should be operating a motor vehicle, Augustino stated no. I determined Augustino was driving while intoxicated in violation of 39:4-50 and he was subsequently placed under arrest. Before being secured in the rear passenger seat of patrol vehicle 20-20, Augustino was placed in handcuffs, double locked, searched, and advised that he would be both video and audio recorded while being transported back to headquarters. South Shore Towing was contacted and responded in order to take custody of the motor vehicle for twelve hours as per John's Law. It should be noted, that due to an emergency first aid call, Augustino's vehicle was not searched as I immediately transported Augustino back to headquarters while Cpl. Cicero responded to the first aid call. Once Cpl. Cicero was finished dealing with the first aid call, he responded back to the location of the motor vehicle stop and a tow report was completed and signed, see attached.

Upon arrival at headquarters, Augustino was escorted to the processing area, where he was removed from handcuffs, searched, and secured in processing area one. Augustino was then read the standard statement form in which he consented to providing samples of his breath for testing, as well as I read Augustino his constitutional rights in which he waived in writing. Cpl. Cicero responded to headquarters for alcotest administration and custody of Augustino was then turned over to Cpl. Cicero; see his supplemental report for additional details.

Upon completion of the alcotest administration, Cpl Cicero advised me that the breath samples provided by Augustino were within the acceptable tolerance and that Augustino's blood alcohol content yielded .17 percent blood alcohol content.

Augustino was issued the following motor vehicle summons with a scheduled court date.

1520-A-053249 for 39:4-50 (Driving while intoxicated).

1520-A-053250 for 39:4-96 (Reckless driving).

1520-A-053251 for 39:4-88B (Failure to maintain lane).

1520-A-053252 for 39:4-51B (Open alcoholic container within a motor vehicle).

Following the completion of processing, along with an intake photograph of Augustino being taken, he was turned over to his girlfriend identified as Jessica Hendricks DOB 04/09/2000 of [REDACTED] Skylark Drive, Toms River, NJ, 08755 who was read and signed the potential liability form after stating she understood the form.

Augustino is not a member of the United States Armed Forces and the above events were memorialized on the assigned body worn cameras of myself and Cpl. Cicero.

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
