The Business Administrator mentioned that in order for a bus trip to be approved it would have to be run with the Recreation Department and have employees that have been background checked and trained to work with kids.

Chris asked if we could have a 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting this month to plan out the summer and move forward on the rest of the events planned for the year.
