Re: Response to OPRA Request (C-2025-112)

Dear Mr. Michael:

This is in response to your Request for Public Records, per **N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.**, the Open Public Records Act (OPRA), received by this Office on September 10, 2025. You requested the following:

“Please provide copies of ANY and ALL invoices and or Purchase Orders for Taser International or AXON.”

Currently, your request fails to identify with reasonable clarity the specific government records sought, as is required by Bent v. Stafford Police Department, 381 N.J. Super. 30, 37 (App. Div. 2005). At this time, we are requesting clarification of your OPRA request. Specifically, your request does not identify a time frame for the requested records. Please respond in writing via email to OPRABCPO@co.burlington.nj.us and identify a time frame for the requested invoices so that we may process your request. Failure to provide written clarification of your request by **September 26, 2025**, will result in the closure of this OPRA request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Burlington to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at Government.Records@dca.nj.gov, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
