- 3 If you wish to cast a WRITE-IN vote (you may not write-in any name in the WRITE-IN column and press the button next to WRITE-IN across the top. Using the alphabetical keyboard below, enter the name of the candidate. Between first and middle name or initial and last name use the arrow pointing to the right. The name you ENTER will appear on the screen. Do not press the cast vote button until all other choices are complete.
- WARNING!** An improperly cast write-in vote will be void. Be sure to enter the name on the same line as the office for which you are casting the write-in vote.
- 4 To vote on the PUBLIC QUESTIONS press the button to the right of your selection.
- 5 After ALL selections have been made, press the RED CAST VOTE button to record all of your votes.

Do you approve amending the State Constitution to set a State minimum wage rate of at least \$8.25 per hour? The amendment also requires annual increases in that rate if there are annual increases in the cost of living.

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

This amendment to the State Constitution sets the State minimum wage at the level in effect under current law, or \$8.25 per hour, whichever is more. Cost of living increases would be added each year. Also, if the federal minimum wage rate is raised above the State rate, the State rate would be raised to match the federal rate. Future cost of living increases then would be added to that raised rate.
